FEDERATIONS INVITED	The Pan American Gymnastics Union invites all Federations affiliated to the PAGU and the FIG and which are up to date in their obligations.
AGE LIMITS	<p>Senior WAG: 16 years and older MAG: 18 years and older <i>Ages as of December 31, 2021</i></p> <p>All gymnasts must have a valid FIG license until the end of the event.</p>
QUALIFICATION FOR OTHER EVENTS	<p>These Championships will serve as qualifying event for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games. JUDGES AND JURIES	<p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline.</p> <p>Each Federation must register 1 judge if participates with 1-2 gymnasts (individuals) and 2 judges if participates with 3-5 gymnasts (teams).</p> <p>Federations can register a second judge (for individuals) or a third judge (for teams), different from the TC Member as additional accredited person, with no cost for this accreditation.</p> <p>The fine for not registering the required number of judges in each discipline is USD\$1,000.00 per missing judge.</p> <p>Federations with a PAGU TC Member can register that Member in addition to their official judges.</p> <p>The fines for not registering the required number of judges must be paid to PAGU by April 9, 2021 at the latest and it does not apply to those Federations that do not have FIG brevet judges in the respective discipline (MAG, WAG). The National Federation must inform PAGU at the time of the definitive registration (April 9, 2021) to allow the appointment of invited neutral judges.</p>

MEDICAL SERVICES	<p>The Local Organizing Committee will provide first aid services and ambulance at the competition and training sites during the official activities.</p>
COVID-19	<p>All participants will take a COVID-19 test upon arrival to the official hotels and must stay in their rooms until the results of the tests are ready.</p> <p>During the trainings and competition periods all participants are allowed to circulate only in the assigned sport venues, as well as in the official hotels.</p>

	<p>Besides the medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions.</p> <p>The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p> <p>The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible, and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.</p> <p>Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and must keep a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p> <p>Additional information will be included in the Work Plan that will be sent to the Federations prior to the event.</p>
VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Brazil Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Brazil. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before <u>May 7, 2021</u> to the LOC.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The host Federation, the LOC, the PAGU and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance, no later than <u>May 7, 2021</u>.</p> <p>The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: USD\$45.00 per person for the official days of the event.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating Federations must pay for the international travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>International Airport of arrival Rio de Janeiro International Airport - Galeão (GIG)</p> <p>The travel itinerary form must be returned to the LOC by <u>May 7, 2021</u>.</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>Local transportation will be offered to and from the airport, provided that the delegations stay in one of the official hotels and book their accommodation through the Local Organizing Committee.</p>

The Local Organizing Committee will provide local transportation from the airport to the hotel and vice versa, only on the official arrival day of Monday May 31 and on the official departure day of Monday June 7 (except for PAGU representatives arriving or departing on different days).

Delegations arriving or departing on non-official days may contact the Local Organizing Committee (pan2021@cbginastica.com.br) to arrange transportation to its accommodation (official hotels) or to the airport at a cost of **USD\$30.00** per person per way (airport-hotel or hotel-airport). The request must be submitted and paid no later than **May 7, 2021**.

The Local Organizing Committee will provide transportation from the official hotels to the competition and training facilities and vice versa, for all members of the delegation duly accredited and according to the official program of activities, provided that the delegation stays in one of the official hotels and books its accommodation through the Local Organizing Committee.


