Federations which have not fulfilled their annual membership fees towards the AGU and FIG and not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Organising Committee will not be allowed to participate in the Asian Championships.</p>
AGE LIMITS	Age limit for Senior RG: 16 years (born in 2005 or before)

<p>COMPETITION FORMAT</p>	<p>Olympic Qualifications For information regarding the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Qualification System please refer to the document published on the FIG web site. The 1 quota place for individual gymnast will be determined based on the results of the all-around final. The 1 quota place for group will be determined based on the results of the all-around competition.</p> <p>Senior individual Hoop – Ball – Clubs – Ribbon Qualifying Competition for the Apparatus Finals and the All-Around final. Competition according to the FIG programme and with the indicated apparatus for the respective year. No more than 3 gymnasts per federation compete in this competition, presenting 8 exercises according to FIG rules in the order fixed by the FIG. Each gymnast must present at least 1 exercise but no more than 4 (a maximum of 1 exercise per apparatus). If a NF participates with only 1 gymnast, she must present an exercise with all 4 apparatus. She can qualify for the All-Around Final and the Apparatus Final. The 3 best exercises will count for the qualification for the All-Around Final. After this competition, the 16 best gymnasts (max. 2 per NF) are qualified for the All-Around Final.</p> <p>All-Around finals The best 16 gymnasts (max. 2 gymnasts per NF) from the qualifications. The gymnasts must present 4 routines. The All-Around ranking result is obtained by adding the 4 scores.</p> <p>Apparatus finals (4 apparatus) of the 8 best gymnasts per apparatus (max. 2 gymnasts per NF) of the Qualifying Competition according to FIG rules.</p> <p>Qualification for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games : <i>The highest placed athlete from the Individual All-Around results of the respective Continental Championships from NOCs not already qualified under Criteria 1 (2019 World Championships) or Criteria 2 (2020/21 World Cup Series), provided that the respective athlete has participated at the 2019 World Championships. The quota place is allocated by name.</i></p> <p>Senior group – 5 balls and 3 hoops & 2 pairs of clubs Competition according to the FIG programme and with 2 different exercises, one executed with 1 apparatus, the other with 2 types of apparatus. The All-Around competition is also a qualifying competition for the Apparatus finals.</p> <p>Apparatus finals Competition of the 8 best groups per apparatus of the Qualifying Competition according to FIG rules.</p> <p>Qualification for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games: <i>The highest ranked NOC from the Group ranking results of the General Competition (All-Around-Qualifications) from the respective Continental Championships in June 2021 not already qualified under Criteria 1 (2018 World Championships) or Criteria 2 (2019 World Championships) will qualify one (1) group quota place, provided that the respective NOC has participated with a Group at the 2018 World Championships.</i></p>

MEDICAL SERVICES	The Organising Committee will provide a first medical aid service, a doctor and emergency medical transportation in the competition area.			

COVID-19	<p>All participants will take a COVID-19 test upon arrival to the official hotels and must stay in their rooms until the results of the tests are ready. During the trainings and competition periods all participants are allowed to circulate only in the assigned sport venues, as well as in the official hotels.</p> <p>Besides the medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions. The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p> <p>The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible, and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout. Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and must keep a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p>
VISA	<p>Please verify immediately via the link: https://mfa.uz/en/pages/visa-republic-uzb if a visa is required for your travel to Uzbekistan. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before 18th May 2021 to the LOC.</p> <p>The procedure of visa issuance is following: You need to fill in the online visa application form on the web site: http://evisa.mfa.uz/evisa_en/ save and send it to us along with the passport copy.</p> <p>The LOC will apply for the visa support letter to the Ministry of foreign affairs. After all arrangements the LOC will send you the letter which should be printed and provided in the Uzbekistan Embassy in your country. If there is no Uzbekistan Embassy or Consulate in your country you will get your visa in Tashkent airport upon arrival. In this Case, please indicate this in the online visa application form.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC, the AGU and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.</p> <p>The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federation own charge as follows: 50 USD per person/day.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 18 of May 2021</p>

During the RG Asian Championships 2021 in Tashkent will be Bubble system.
