The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) is looking forward to welcoming you to Pesaro for the 2021 Edition of Rhythmic Gymnastics World Cup. The LOC is adopting all the necessary measures in order to preserve Gymnasts and Delegations' health and safety during their stay in Pesaro during the competition.

The purpose of this document is to provide the necessary information, instructions and guidelines in the matter of health and safety prevention during the sport event with reference to COVID-19.

During the RG World Cup, the main purpose is to effectively minimize the risk of spreading of COVID-19.

All the participants must respect laws and regulations of Italian central and local Government restriction concerning events held in Italy during the pandemic. In any case Central and local Government regulations always prevail over the requirements and recommendations contained in the present document.

For your information the event will be without audience.

The Chief Medical Officer (CMO) of the event as the director of the medical working team for COVID-19 will follow the actual rules redacted by the Italian Health Ministry, World Health Organization (WHO) and the medical planning of the FIG competition is based on the following main documents : "Medical Organization of the FIG Competitions and Events" and "Medical Guidelines for FIG Competitions and Events during The Covid-19 Pandemic".

BEFORE ARRIVALS

- All attendees flying to Italy must **bring a printed medical certificate reporting a negative coronavirus (COVID-19) PCR test result issued at most 48 hours before departure of flight.**
We suggest you to bring at least five copies of your PCR test result.

(A negative test result of PCR test is mandatory **also for vaccinated attendees**).

BEFORE COMPETITION (AT ACCREDITATION POINT)

- All Attendees are required to undergo a **Quick Covid-19 test upon arrival at accreditation point;**
- The quick Covid-19 test upon arrival is **mandatory also for Vaccinated attendees;**
- No accreditation will be issued without negative quick COVID-19 test result.

In case of positive result to quick COVID-19 test a PCR test will be required (€ 55,00 per person to be paid on spot):

- The attendee will wait for PCR COVID-19 test result in the hotel room;
- **If the Quick COVID-19 test is positive, and the confirming PCR COVID-19 test is negative,** the person is free to go to the competition venue to get his accreditation and participate in the competitions.
- **If the Quick COVID-19 test is positive, and the confirming PCR COVID-19 test is positive,** the person will be isolated in the hotel room to do quarantine for 14 days. Any additional costs of the hotel are in charge of your Delegation.

PCR COVID-19 TEST BEFORE RETURN TO YOUR COUNTRY

- The Local Organizing Committee will make sure that PCR test that you booked and paid before arrival will be arranged before leaving the Country;
- At accreditation point you will receive the timetable of your booked PCR Test.

Besides we inform you that:

- Training and competition hall floors will be sanitized during the breaks;
- **Local shuttle service** will be fully dedicated to Delegations. In case of 2 or more Delegations on the same shuttle bus, each Delegation are asked to keep 1 mt distance;
The LOC is taking care of arranging all transfers by adopting all the necessary safety measures.
- During the **award ceremony**, medals and flower bouquets will be placed on one tray held by one hostess. In order to avoid any physical contact hostesses and awarding person will move close to Gymnasts. Each Gymnast will pick her medal and flower bouquet. The awarding person will verbally congratulate.

COVID-19 Know The Facts

COVID-19 spreads primarily from person to person



- Droplets released when someone sick sneezes or coughs can land on the mouths or noses of people nearby
- Close contact with someone sick – like hugging or shaking hands
