Make sure that your gymnasts use only FIG certified Hand Apparatus for this event and for any other FIG recognized competitions, as they will not be allowed to compete with an Apparatus which does not comply with the norms.</p> <p><b>Random checks on the FIG and Manufacturers' Logos will be carried out at any time during the Event.</b></p>

<b>Age Limits</b>	<b>Juniors:</b> born in 2006, 2007, 2008 <b>Seniors:</b> Born in 2005 and older <b>All Gymnasts must have a current valid FIG license until the end of the competition.</b>																																																						
<b>Judges</b>	<b>All participating judges must have a current FIG brevet (cat. I, II, III, IV) at the time of the competition, in the respective discipline RGI and/or RGG.</b> The participating Member Federations must provide minimum one qualified judge as mentioned above. Failure to do so will result a fine of 150,00€ - to be paid to the LOC upon arrival.																																																						
<b>Entry Fee</b>	The non-reimbursable entry Fee is: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 60,00€ per Individual Gymnast</li> <li>• 100,00€ per Group</li> <li>• 40,00€ per each team member who does not choose to book accommodation through the LOC.</li> </ul>																																																						
<b>MEDICAL SERVICES</b>	The LOC will provide a first medical aid service.																																																						
<b>COVID-19</b>	All participants will take a COVID-19 test upon arrival to the official hotels and must stay in their rooms until the results of the tests are ready. During the trainings and competition periods all participants are allowed to circulate only in the assigned sport venues, as well as in the official hotels.  Besides the medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions. The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible. The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible, and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.																																																						

	<p>Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and must keep a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p>								
<b>Drawing of lots</b>	One week before the competition starts, in the National Federation's offices.

<b>Accommodation Policy</b>	<p>The <a href="#">Accommodation Form (click to complete)</a> must be returned to the LOC <b>by July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021</b> at the very latest, the hotel rooms will be allocated on a "first-come, first-served" basis.</p> <p>The invited participating federations must pay for the accommodation expenses of their delegation members. <b>The costs for the accommodation must be paid to the LOC as follows: 50% until July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and the rest 50% until August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021.</b></p> <p>Please notify the LOC for your choice on the hotel class when your provisional registration is made.</p> <p><b>Cancellation/Reimbursement Policy:</b></p> <p>50% of accommodation costs are refundable in case of cancellations at least 1 month prior to arrival. For cancellations made after August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021 there will be no reimbursement.</p> <p><b>NOTE: No Hotel Reservations will be secured, for delegations that will not pay in time.</b></p>

<b>Visa</b>	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Greece Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Greece. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that <a href="#">Visa request (click to complete)</a> is made <b>before July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021</b> to the LOC.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Members as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>								

**Insurance**

The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.

The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photo copy of the valid policy).

Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.

The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: 30,00€ per person/day.

**NOTE: In the case of any medical services in the hospital, the cost must be covered by the delegations.**

**Music and Music Forms**

Music files have to be sent in .mp3 format. Name of each file must contain:

- The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country)
- The first and last name of the individual competitor
- The category (individual/group);
- The apparatus
- The Junior or Senior

(Example: ROU\_RADU\_Alina\_Junior\_Group\_5hoops.mp3)

Delegation members are requested to keep in their possession a specimen of their CD and USB key for their training sessions and in case of a technical problem.

At the accreditation, the Heads of delegation have to hand in the Music Release form which you will receive together with the workplan.

**Accreditation**

Delegation accreditation will take place upon arrival. For accreditation team leaders are required to bring the following documents:

- passports of all members of the delegation
- FIG licenses for junior and senior gymnasts
- fulfilment of all financial obligations
- the medical insurance of all members of the delegation
