Games of the XXXII Olympiad Tokyo (JPN), 23 July – 08 August 2021

ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS DRAWING OF LOTS PROCEDURES

We are pleased to hereby submit the procedures for the MAG and WAG drawing of lots for the Games of the XXXII Olympiad in Tokyo (JPN).

Important Note: This draw takes into account the lists of teams and individual gymnasts officially qualified through the Tokyo 2020 Qualification System as communicated on 28 June 2021 by the FIG. The NOCs' participation confirmations still need to be formally received.

General Principles

MAG and WAG gymnasts will be divided into groups consisting either of:

- **Country Groups:** for countries with teams and, if any, additional one or two individual gymnast(s), or
- **Mixed Groups:** for countries with individual gymnasts and no teams.

Qualifications

First step: to draw the individual gymnasts – without teams - into the Mixed Groups.

For **MAG:** out of 6 Mixed Groups, 4 will be composed of 7 gymnasts and 2 will be composed of 6 gymnasts.
For **WAG:** out of 8 Mixed Groups, 6 will be composed of 5 gymnasts and 2 will be composed of 6 gymnasts.

For MAG

- To prepare the Mixed Group cards and put them into bowl #2.
- To prepare the cards with the names of countries with 4 individual gymnasts and put them into bowl #1. To draw the country from bowl #1, then the Mixed Group from bowl #2, until all countries with 4 individual gymnasts are assigned.
- To prepare the cards with the names of countries with 3 individual gymnast and put them into bowl #1. To draw the country from bowl #1, then the Mixed Groups from bowl #2, until all countries with 3 individual gymnasts are assigned
- To prepare the cards with the names of countries with 2 individual gymnasts and put them into bowl #1. To draw the country from bowl #1, then the Mixed Group from bowl #2, until all countries with 2 individual gymnasts are assigned.
- To prepare the cards with the names of countries with 1 individual gymnast and put them into bowl #1. To draw the country from bowl #1, then the Mixed Groups from bowl #2, until all countries with 1 individual gymnast are assigned.

For WAG

- To prepare the Mixed Group cards and put them into bowl #2.
- To prepare the cards with the names of countries with 2 individual gymnasts and put them into bowl #1. To draw the country from bowl #1, then the Mixed Group from bowl #2, until all countries with 2 individual gymnasts are assigned.
- To prepare the cards with the names of countries with 1 individual gymnast and put them into bowl #1. To draw the country from bowl #1, then the Mixed Groups from bowl #2, until all countries with 1 individual gymnast are assigned.

Second step: to draw the Country Groups - with teams and, if any, additional one or two individual gymnast(s) - and the Mixed Groups into the Subdivisions Number and the Apparatus

For **MAG**: all 3 Subdivisions will be composed of 4 Country Groups and 2 Mixed Groups

For **WAG**: 3 Subdivisions will be composed of 2 Country Groups and 2 Mixed Groups; 2 Subdivisions will be composed of 3 Country Groups and 1 Mixed Group.

- To prepare the Country Groups cards and the Mixed Groups cards and put them into bowl #1.
- To prepare the cards indicating the Subdivisions' Number and the Apparatus within the Subdivision and put them into bowl #2.
- To draw alternately from bowl #1 and bowl #2, until all Country Groups and Mixed Groups are assigned.

Special Provisions

After the draw, in case of gymnast's withdrawal, the following principles will be considered to draw the reallocated place:

For NOCs with more than one gymnast:

- 1) The replacing gymnast with a team to be drawn in the same Country Group.
- 2) The replacing gymnast without a team to be drawn in the same Mixed Group if the maximum of 7 gymnasts for MAG and 6 for WAG is not reached in the Mixed Group concerned.
- 3) The replacing gymnast without a team to be drawn in a different Mixed Group if the maximum of 7 gymnasts for MAG and 6 for WAG is already reached in the Mixed Group concerned.
- 4) The replacing gymnast without a team to be drawn in a Country Group if the maximum of 7 gymnasts for MAG and 6 for WAG is reached in all Mixed Groups. For the draw in the Country Group, priority to be given to Group with 4, then 5, then if needed, 6 gymnasts.

For NOCs with one gymnast:

- 1) In case of withdrawal in a Mixed Group, the replacing gymnast to be drawn in the exact same position as the gymnast withdrawn
- 2) In case of withdrawal in a Country Group, the replacing gymnast to be drawn in a Mixed Group if the maximum of 7 gymnasts for MAG and 6 for WAG is not reached in all Mixed Groups.
- 3) In case of withdrawal in a Country Group, the replacing gymnast to be drawn in a Country Group if the maximum of 7 gymnasts for MAG and 6 for WAG is reached in all Mixed Groups. For the draw in the Country Group, priority to be given to Groups with 4, then 5, then if needed, 6 gymnasts.

Team Final

The teams ranked 1-8 after the Qualification are seeded as identified in the Starting Order chart. The teams rotate from one event to another as per the international apparatus order, as identified in the Working Order chart.

All-Around Final

The gymnasts ranked 1-24 after the Qualifications are seeded in international apparatus order into one subdivision, as identified in the Starting Order chart. The individuals rotate from one event to another as per the international apparatus order, as identified in the Working Order chart.

Apparatus Finals

In order to establish the Working order on each apparatus, a draw is carried out, until the positions 1-8 are filled.

Podium Training and Training Groups

Podium Training and Training Groups follow the Qualification draw order by subdivision and apparatus.
