YEARLY WINNER

The yearly winner of the World Challenge Cup Series is the Individual Gymnasts/Groups with the highest number of points of each of the World Challenge Cup Series Ranking List of the respective year.

- If 4 or more World Challenge Cup Competitions take place per year, the best results (maximum 3) are counted, regardless of the number of competitions the Individual Gymnast/Group participated in
- If 3 World Challenge Competitions take place per year all results are counted, regardless of the number of competitions the Individual Gymnast/Group participated in

A special award ceremony will be held at the last World Challenge Cup Competition of the year in which the winning Individual Gymnast/Group shall receive a Cup.

MEDICAL SERVICES	LOC will provide a first medical aid service, a doctor and emergency medical transportation from the competition area.
COVID 19	<p>Besides the FIG medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions.</p> <p>The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible.</p> <p>The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.</p> <p>Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible.</p>

DOPING CONTROLS	The Organizing Member Federation will provide at its own charge a minimum of 3 doping controls for Individual gymnasts and 3 for Groups. The doping control will be organized by the National Anti-Doping Agency of Belarus.

TELEVISION	<p>Television coverage is compulsory.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation must guarantee the production of a basic feed (international signal). SCORING, RESULT SERVICE AND VIDEO CONTROL	<p>The Organising Member Federation must provide a scoring and result service with outputs as provided by the official scorer / data handling provider at FIG World Championships, including a high quality video system which allows the recording, storage and provision of compilation of the recorded images for the Difficulty Judges, the Superior Jury and the President of the Superior Jury. The videos must be sent to the FIG office within one week after the competition.</p> <p>Throughout the competition, the system must be able to redisplay in real time, normal speed, slow motion or fixed image, the different sequences and the registered scores of every exercise performed for the Technical Delegate. The scoring and result system must include a TV graphics generator.
