The list of the RG Hand Apparatus with valid certificates is published on the FIG website ( <a href="#">here</a> ) and updated regularly. Make sure that your gymnasts use only FIG certified Hand Apparatus for this event and for any other FIG recognized competitions, as they will not be allowed to compete with an Apparatus which does not comply with the norms.  <b>Random checks on the FIG and Manufacturers' Logos will be carried out at any time during the Event.</b>

<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	Accreditation will take place upon arrival. <b>MEDICAL SERVICES</b>	The Organizing Committee will provide a first medical aid service.				
<b>COVID 19</b>	All participants will take a COVID-19 test upon arrival to the official hotels and must stay in their rooms until the results of the tests are ready. During the trainings and competition periods all participants are allowed to circulate only in the assigned sport venues, as well as in the official hotels.				

	<p>Besides the medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions.</p> <p>The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p> <p>The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible, and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.</p> <p>Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and must keep a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p> <p><b>Actual information:</b></p> <p>Every delegation can enter to Czech Republic with PCR test no older than 72 hours before entering the Czech Republic and with the official invitation for the competition.</p> <p>At the moment, the neighbours of the Czech Republic and the countries of the Shengen zone plus the countries that have mutual agreement with the Czech Republic, can enter the Czech Republic without PCR test, if they can verify that they are protected against Covid-19. <b>VISA</b>	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Czech Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to the Czech Republic.</p> <p>The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before July 3rd, 2021 to the LOC.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship, passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>
<b>INSURANCE</b>	<p>The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.</p>
<b>INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by August 3rd, 2021.</p>
<b>LOCAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	<p>LOC will provide transportation for all participants (from/to Vienna Schwechat Int. Airport) as well as transfers and international transportations will only be available to those who book accommodation directly with LOC.</p> <p><b>Transportation from and to the International Airport Vienna – 10 EUR/per person.</b></p> <p><b>Local transportation in Brno is free.</b></p>
