



## Gymnastics - Team Leaders' Guide Edits and Additions

### GENERAL

For Artistic Gymnastics (GAR), only the following competition terms will be used:  
Qualifications, and not CI (also the same for GRY & GTR)  
All-Around Final, and not CII  
Apparatus Finals, and not CIII  
Team Final, and not CIV

Page 9- Technical Operations Manager – Artistic: AKENA, Akiko (JPN)

All disciplines- ITO lists have been updated, some changes have occurred

Page 11- Remove from Jury of Appeal list: A-Rahman AL-SHATHRI

Page 12- Remove from Rhythmic Gymnastics Jury Members- Liubou CHARKASHYNA

Page 22- Rhythmic Gymnastics. "Team events" should be "Group events"

Page 22- The Trampoline Gymnastics (GTR) LAR was omitted

Should be as follows:

LAR is only allowed for slots allocated to an NOC, and only up until twenty-four (24) hours prior to the beginning of ~~Competition~~ Qualifications. Any athlete for which an accreditation application has been submitted by the accreditation deadline may be used as replacement provided he/she is eligible.

Please note that the LAR process and approval might take up to 18 hours and must be concluded by the final confirmation of athletes for the respective event.

For more detailed and up-to-date information on athlete replacement procedures, please refer to the latest version of the IOC LAR Policy and the Late Athlete Replacement Sport-Specific Procedures. If you do not have direct access to these documents, please contact your NOC to request a copy.

Page 102- Marathon and Race Walk. Not part of the Gymnastics programme. Remove entire section.

### SPECIFIC DISCIPLINES

Page 23- GAR only- Clothing and equipment- ~~Team gymnasts and Individual gymnasts should compete in uniforms of different colours/designs.~~ During the Qualification competition of the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games, the additional individual gymnasts from a NOC with a qualified team must wear a distinctively different colour singlet (MAG) and leotard (WAG) than the gymnasts participating in the team event.



Page 33- GRY only-

- Ironing board. An iron and ironing board will be available for the purpose of straightening ribbons.
- Apparatus measuring station. An apparatus-measuring station will be available for gymnasts to check that their apparatus complies with FIG regulations. This will be located close to the final warm-up carpet within the warm-up hall.

Page 50 & 52- GAR- Music CDs will need to be delivered during the first day of training, 19 July

Page 51- GAR Clarification

Old Text- For CI, the starting order for each rotation of the gymnasts making up a team will be decided by each NOC. NOCs with more than one individual gymnast who have two slots in a given rotation must submit the starting order of gymnasts for each rotation. Starting orders must be submitted on the form O-GA-07 (MAG) and O-GA-09 (WAG).

New text:

Starting orders and number of vaults must be submitted on the forms: O-GA-07 (MAG) and O-GA-09 (WAG).

For NOCs with Teams-

For Qualifications, the starting order for each rotation of the gymnasts making up a team will be decided by each NOC. NOCs with teams and +1 or +2 individual gymnasts must also include these individual gymnasts on the same form, and must designate the start order if they have +2 individuals (start order 1 & 2 between them on each apparatus). Every gymnast (team and individuals) must be shown on the form, even one individual, because the form also includes the designation of one or two vaults to be performed.

For NOCs with Individuals-

Individual gymnasts in the mixed groups must also submit a start order form. Federations with more than one individual may determine the start order of their gymnasts on each apparatus. Every gymnast must be shown on a form, even one individual, because the form also includes the designation of one or two vaults to be performed.

Page 52- GAR- Confirmation of Starting Orders Deadline Times

10:00 for Qualifications for GAR Men (23 July) & GAR Women (24 July)

19:00 for Team Final for GAR Men (25 July)

19:45 for Team Final for GAR WAG (26 July)

17:00 for GAR Confirmation of Withdrawal from the Apparatus Finals



Page 53- GAR- Technical Meeting should replace the term Orientation Meeting throughout

Page 54- GAR- Call to Competition. "After entering the Field of play, gymnasts should present themselves in front of the judges on the podium before the competition begins." Further details regarding the subsequent rotations will be presented at the Technical Meeting

Page 54- GAR- "For ~~the Team Final~~, immediately following the initial procession of gymnasts, all ~~four five~~ gymnasts from each team will present themselves on the podium in front of the judges and will be announced to the audience." The correct number of team gymnasts is four.

Page 55-56- GAR- Adjustment of apparatus. This section is repeated on both pages.

"For the women's competitions, an additional accredited person may enter the field of play in order to aid the preparation of the Uneven Bars or to remove the board. This person may only enter the gates to the Field of play. Once finished, he/she must immediately leave the field of play." More specific details will be reviewed at the Technical Meeting because men can also have an accredited person enter the FOP.

During the warm-up period in Qualifications, the gymnast may be assisted ~~by a second coach (male or female)~~, as defined in the FIG Code of Points.

Page 56- GAR- "Return to warm-up hall during competition. During CI, gymnasts may return to the Warm-up hall but may not use the apparatus." This is not the case. During Qualifications, gymnasts may return to the Warm-up hall. They may use the stretching area and the apparatus, with priority still being given to the gymnasts warming-up for the next subdivision (if any) for the use of the apparatus. A gymnast must ask for permission to use a piece of apparatus already in use by or assigned to a team or individual(s) from the next subdivision.

~~If the gap between the (avg.) 'D' score deductions and the 'RD' score exceeds the predefined permitted~~



~~tolerances, the average of the 'RD' and the D-Jury will form the final 'D' score.~~

~~If the gap between the (avg.) 'E' score and the 'RE' score exceeds the predefined permitted tolerances, the average of the 'RE' and the 'E' scores will form the final 'E' score.~~

~~If the gap between the (avg.) 'ET' score and the (avg.) 'ETR' score exceeds the predefined permitted tolerances, the average of the 'ETR' and the 'ET' scores will form the final 'ET' score.~~

Add the following:

The ETR deductions decide the maximum allowed delta between the respective ETR deductions and the ET deductions. In case the delta is equal to or less than the allowed tolerance, the score of the ET stands; in case the delta is greater than the allowed tolerance the average of the ETR and ET deductions forms the "final" ET-Score.

In case the gap between the deductions of the 2 ETR is bigger than predefined tolerances, the ETR deductions are not taken into account at all.

Page 76- GRY- Remove Supplementary Access Control Device (SACD) section, does not apply to GRY

Page 77- GRY- Submission of pre-competition forms. The deadline for submission of the Start Order of Competition form for NOCs with 2 Individual athletes was omitted. This form and the deadline can be confirmed at the SID at the training venue upon the first visit.

Page 78- GRY- Presentation to field of play. This will be reviewed in detail at the Technical Meeting.
