GYMNASTS' DRAWING OF LOTS PROCEDURES

We are pleased to provide you with the procedures for the RG Individual and Groups' drawing of lots for the 38th FIG Rhythmic Gymnastics World Championship in Kitakyushu (JPN).

General principles for Individual and for Group competitions:

The order of the apparatus for Individuals and Groups are pre-defined (RGI Hoop & Ball, Clubs & Ribbon, RGG 5 Balls, 3 Hoops & 2 pairs of Clubs).

- Random drawing of lots will be carried out by computer for all phases of competitions.
- Drawing of lots will be conducted in the following order of priority:
 1. Individual Qualification
 2. Individual All-Around Final
 3. Individual Apparatus Finals
 4. Group All-Around Competition
 5. Group Finals

Individual Competitions – Qualifications

The drawing of lots will determine the starting order of each National Federation. Gymnasts from the same Federation will perform in the same apparatus alternatively.

Once completed, the draw will be divided into four (4) Groups of individual gymnasts (group A, B, C and D). Each 4 Groups will then be cut into two (2) subgroups (A1/A2, B1/B2, C1/C2, D1/D2).

The order of the 4 Groups will rotate for the second day of qualification but the order of the gymnasts within each Group will not change.

1st day of competition:

1. Group A will start followed by Groups B, C and D.
2. First subgroup of each Group will start followed by the second subgroup of the same Group (A1/A2, B1/B2, C1/C2, D1/D2).

2nd day of competition:

1. Group B will start followed by Groups A, D and C.
2. Second subgroup of each Group will start followed by the first subgroup of the same Group (B2/B1, A2/A1, D2/D1, C2/C1).

Individuals Competitions – All-Around Final

In order to establish the starting order on the All-Around Final two (2) draws will be carried out as follows:

First draw:

1st rotation – Individual gymnasts ranked 10 - 18 of the Qualifications

- To fulfill the starting order 1 - 9 of the 1st rotation of the All-Around Final, a random draw will be carried out with the Individual gymnasts ranked 10 – 18 of the Qualifications.

Second draw:

2nd rotation – Individual gymnasts ranked 1 - 9 of the Qualifications

- To fulfill the starting order 1 - 9 of the 2nd rotation of the All-Around Final, a random draw will be carried out with the Individual gymnasts ranked 1 - 9 of the Qualifications.

Individuals - Apparatus Finals

In order to establish the starting order on each Apparatus Final, four (4) different drawing of lots will be carried out until the positions 1- 8 are filled in each apparatus.

Group Competitions – General Competition

The drawing of lots will determine the starting order of each Federation. Once all Federations will be assigned, the draw will be divided into two (2) Groups (A and B).

1. Group A will start the competition and perform alternatively the exercise using one type of apparatus and two types of apparatus. Then a rotation is made within Group A for all Groups to perform the second exercise (two types of apparatus and one type of apparatus).
2. Same principle for Group B.

Group Finals - Finals for the exercise using one and two types of apparatus

In order to establish the starting order on each type of apparatus, two (2) different draws are carried out until the positions 1-8 are filled for each apparatus.
