MEDICAL SERVICES	Organizing Committee will provide first aid and medical services.
COVID-19	<p>Besides the medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions.</p> <p>The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible.</p> <p>The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.</p> <p>Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible.</p> <p>Due to the dynamic situation regarding the COVID-19 pandemic, we will keep you posted regarding all prevailing COVID-19 measures on the Delegation website: https://www.enbw-dtbpokal.de/delegations/.</p>
VISA	<p>The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before 15.01.2022 to the LOC. The request must include the passport copy, function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation, etc.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.</p> <p>The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations' own charge as follows: 15 € per person/day.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must cover all international travel costs of their delegation members. The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 17 January 2022.</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The LOC will provide free local transportation for all participants from/to all airports of Moscow, railway station and/or bus station as well as from/to the official hotel and the Competition Venue.</p>
