PARTICIPATION RIGHT AND ACCREDITATIONS

Updated rules for entry into Uzbekistan came into force on 16 March 2022:

- Passengers (over 12) travelling to Uzbekistan from foreign countries with a COVID 19 certificate of vaccination or a vaccination passport will not be required to take a PCR or rapid-antigen test before departure.
- If not, passengers must provide a negative PCR (valid for 72 hours) or a rapid-antigen tests results.
- All the above mentioned documents/certificates must have a QR code.

The approved list of laboratories is available on the official website of the Sanitary and Epidemiological Service of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the section COVID 19 LAB (<http://sanepid.uz/oz>).

If any delegation needs to take the PCR test for return, it should contact LOC.

Delegations that have safely passed the border at the airport will be transferred by special vehicles to the hotel at their place of residence during the competition. Representatives of the organizing committee will provide accreditation, training schedule, bus schedule. Each delegation is obliged to provide the preventative of the organizing committee with the following copies of documents:

- present to the LOC a valid passport of all Delegation Members for proof of identity and control of Nationality
- make any necessary payments (insurance, accommodation, additional accreditation, etc.)
- show proof of the cover note or photocopy of the valid insurance policy
- check the correct names of their complete Delegation
- verify the accommodation and meal requirements
- verify the return flight schedules
- submit the CD with the Federation National Anthem, and sign the relevant form
- submit the CD with the Music for each gymnast and group, and sign the relevant form.
- submit the National Flag, and sign the relevant form.

Accreditation Principles

The accreditation identifies individuals in good standing from FIG affiliated federations participating in the event. The accreditation is personal and non-transferable. It indicates and defines individuals' right to access to the different zones as per their functions, as well as to the transport system from the LOC.

The access to the Competition and Warm-up Hall is strictly limited to the gymnasts participating in the specific competition and according to the warm-up and competition schedules. All participants and officials are required to wear their Accreditation Cards at all times. The accreditation card is also necessary to pass the security controls. In case of lost or stolen accreditation cards, the LOC must be informed immediately to block the accreditation.

All questions regarding payment of accommodation, meals, participation fees, stamping on documents, etc. - one representative of the delegation can discuss on the day of testing in the main office of the Uzbekistan Gymnastics Federation (Financial Department)

Delegation Seating

The LOC will reserve a number of seats for the seating of the accredited Delegation members in the venue. These seats will be available on a first come, first served basis. Delegates will be requested not to sit in any other spectator seats within the arena unless permitted to do so by a representative of the LOC. Reserved places will also be put at the disposal of Press, Radio, Television, Photographers, authorized officials and guests of honors.

INSURANCE

MUSIC

While the CD with music for each routine and each gymnast/group should be submitted to the LOC during accreditation. Coaches are also requested to always have 1 CD with them as backup for safety reasons or in case of technical problems. All CDs must be labeled as according to point 1.5.8 of the COP. During competitions, Podium training and training the music will be played by computer.

CHANGE TO THE LISTS OF NAMES

Please refer to Section 1 Regulation 4.2 of FIG Technical Regulations for details on the provisions related to the changes to the lists of names.

For accreditation changes requests (function and / or name):

- made from the Nominative registration until Accreditation, send immediately by e-mail to the FIG the official form (Appendix 1 and/or 2) for proper evaluation of your query.
- made from Accreditation until 24 hours prior to the start of qualification, please report immediately to the Accreditation Centre for proper evaluation of your query by FIG (Technical Delegate) (Appendix 1 and/or 2).

TRANSPORTATION

Please refer to the directives for details on Transportations.

As a reminder, only accredited persons from Delegations staying at one of the official hotels, having booked their accommodation through the LOC and returned to the LOC their Travel Form in due course (01 April, 2022) are entitled to use the event local transportation from/to the airport, hotel, venue, etc. All other Delegation members are not entitled to use the LOC transportation system and will be responsible to be on time!

Arrivals

The LOC personnel will be present at all arrival points with greeting signs to welcome the Delegation Members. Delegations will be requested to make their ways to meet with them.

Departures

Shuttle transportation will be coordinated by the LOC from the Official Hotels to the official airport, main railway station based on the Travel Forms from the delegation and confirmed by Head of Delegation during accreditation. **Shuttle transportation for departure will be at the official hotels 3 hours before the flight time.**

TRAINING - PODIUM TRAINING - EARLY TRAINING

Training

The Official detailed training schedules have been organized in accordance with the Technical Regulations.

The training and competitions schedules will be published on the FIG online calendar in due time. Delegations must respect the designated training times and the allocated training carpets. Changes to the official scheduled training hours will not be accepted. Each Individual gymnast/Group have the same possibility of training session.

Podium training

Only on podium training day, Individual gymnasts and/or Groups will perform their exercises on the floor where the competition will take place.

KISS & CRY

The number of persons authorized in the Kiss & Cry is:

- Individual Competition: 1 Gymnast and 1 Coach
- Group Competition: max 6 Gymnasts and 1 Coach

Further information will be given at the Orientation Meeting.

CONTROL OF APPARATUS

During the Podium trainings for Individuals and for Groups, each Delegation will have the opportunity to have their leotard and apparatus verified should they wish to.

Random checks on the FIG and Manufacturers' Logos will be carried out during the World Cup in Tashkent. Gymnasts will not be allowed to compete with an Apparatus which does not comply with the norms.

ANNOUNCEMENTS DURING COMPETITIONS

During the competitions, the announcements will be made in Russian, Uzbek and English.

SCORING

The Sportvokrug will provide the official scoring equipment for the World Cup. The Sportvokrug equipment will be used for the data management of the gymnasts' start lists, judges' lists, scores and results.

INQUIRY

Please refer to Technical Regulation, Section 1, Reg. 8.4.

Inquiries for the difficulty scores are allowed (Appendix 3), provided that they are made verbally immediately after the publication of the score or at the very latest before the score of the following gymnast or group is shown. For the last gymnast of a rotation, this limit is one minute after the score is shown on the score board.

The person designated to receive the verbal inquiry (LOC Inquiry Officer) has to note the time of receiving it and this starts the procedure. Only the accredited coaches in the competition area are entitled to submit an inquiry. The inquiry form will be available on the Inquiry Desk. The expected score must be mentioned on the inquiry form for the inquiry to be accepted. An area close to the Kiss & Cry where the coach of the competing gymnast can see the score of the exercise will be designated. Late verbal inquiries will be rejected.

A National Federation is not allowed to complain against a gymnast from another federation. Inquiries for Execution scores are not allowed.

The inquiry must be confirmed as soon as possible in writing but within 4 minutes at the latest after the verbal inquiry and requires an agreement of payment of:

USD 300.-- for the first complaint

USD 500.-- for the second complaint

USD 1'000.-- for the third complaint

Federations shall not pay cash when submitting an inquiry (no cash money on the FOP); invoices will be sent later by the FIG Headquarters to the National Federations concerned. Should the inquiry not be confirmed in writing within 4 minutes, the procedure becomes obsolete.

Should the inquiry prove correct and is accepted, this sum will not be invoiced by FIG to the National Federation. Otherwise, the sum will be invoiced by FIG to the National Federation and will be transferred to the FIG Foundation.

Every inquiry must be examined by the Technical Delegate and a final decision which may not be appealed must be taken at the very latest:

- at the end of the rotation for the Qualifications
- before the score of the following gymnast is shown for the Apparatus Finals

CEREMONIES

Opening Ceremony

The official Opening Ceremony will take place in the Gymnastics Sports palace **on 15th April at 18.00.**

All Delegation members are invited to present as spectators.

Further detailed information will be given during the Orientation Meeting.

Award Ceremonies

The awards ceremonies **will be held as per the schedule enclosed (SAT. 16 Apr. 18:00 – 18:20 - Award Ceremony for All-Around RGI and RGG; SUN. 17 Apr. 13.29 – 13:49 - Award Ceremonies RGI Hoop, RGI Ball, RGG 5 Hoops Finals; SUN. 17 Apr. 15:16 – 15:36 - Award Ceremony for RGI Clubs, RGI Ribbon, RGG 3 Ribbons + 2 Balls Finals)** and carried out in accordance with the FIG Regulations for Award Ceremonies.

All the winners will be awarded by the medals and flowers. The e-version of the diplomas will be send to NF by email.

The athletes must wear their **national tracksuits** for the Award Ceremony. In case of infractions, the respective Federation will receive only 50% of the prize money (Technical Regulations, section 1, Art. 9.3.3).

The national flags of the best 3 Individual Gymnasts or Groups will be hoisted and the national anthem of the top Individual Gymnast(s), or Group(s) will be played.

Please ensure that your Federation's medalists are in time for the line-up prior to the ceremonies. An Individual Gymnast or a Group who is absent with unjustified reason will be disqualified.

MEDICAL SERVICES

The medical service is provided by the Local Organizing Committee according to the FIG Rules "MEDICAL ORGANIZATION OF THE FIG COMPETITIONS and EVENTS"

The team doctor or one of the team representatives must join the personal number of the head doctor LOC (Svyatskaya Svetlana Ivanovna) on the WhatsApp or Telegram at (+998) 909385774.

PCR TEST

The Organizing Committee will ensure the presence of a special laboratory for the PCR test, on the territory of the Gymnastics Federation of Uzbekistan (medical unit), in case the delegations need it for return. You must have a copy of your passport!!! The cost of a PCR test per person is 250,000 sums (approximately \$25).

Payment is accepted in national currency or Visa cards, at the laboratory's cashier during the delivery of PCR tests.

DOPING CONTROL AND THERAPEUTIC USE EXEMPTIONS

Under the supervision of the FIG, doping control will be organized according to the current WADA Code, WADA International Standards and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.

The doping controls may take place at any time.

As per the applicable FIG Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) procedure in effect concerning the participation at FIG Events, any gymnast in need of a TUE is responsible, together with her Federation, to submit her request to the FIG no later than 30 days before the start of this competition. No TUE request will be accepted nor approved on spot, except for duly justified emergency cases.

The Organizing Member Federation will provide at its own charge a minimum of 4 doping controls for individual gymnasts and 4 for Groups under the control of FIG Anti Doping.

PRIZE MONEY

In order to receive cash prizes, a gymnast must come to the head office of the Uzbekistan Gymnastics Federation (Financial Department), at the end of the award ceremony on April 17 (before 18:00).

MEETINGS - INSTRUCTIONS - ORIENTATION MEETING

Judges' Instruction for RGI and RGG judges will take place in the Judges' Room at the Gymnastics Sports Palace (Judges' Meeting Room (VIP Zone):

- on 14th April 2022 at 09.00
- on 15th April 2022 at 12.00
- on 16th April 2022 at 12.00
- on 17th April 2022 at 10.30

On the 14th-16th April 2022, the lunch will be provided for Judges by LOC.

On the 14th April 2022, the friendly dinner (at 18.30 from the Gymnastics Sports Palace) will be provided for Judges by LOC

The Orientation Meeting will take place in the Judges Room at the Gymnastics Sports Palace on 14th April 2022 at 18.30.

Participation is compulsory.

Delegation representatives have to attend this meeting with a maximum of 1 accredited member per Delegation.

INFORMATION DESK

INFORMATION DESK will be set up in the Gymnastics Sport Palace.

All information regarding competition, warm-up, and trainings, notification of meetings, transport, results, start lists, as well as FIG and LOC correspondences will be distributed.
