ACCREDITATION	<p>Accreditations can be collected, by the Head of Delegation or Team Manager at the Orientation Meetings.</p> <p>Head of Delegation must carry the following items on them:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Passports of all members of the delegation• Insurances of all members of the delegation• National anthem (on USB) and national flag (1800x900mm)• Competitors’ music WAG & RG (USB)• Proof for full payment of the costs due to the LOC• Licence of the gymnast <p>At the Venue Accreditation Checkpoints will be placed to limit access to operational areas to ensure the athletes, technical officials, volunteers and staff can operate to the highest possible level. GCSLC will provide two Security Guards who are located at the spectator entry to GCSLC Arena.</p> <p>FOP access will be limited to those that are appropriately accredited and also doing a job at a particular time. There will potentially be a large number of persons that have the accreditation level to be on the FOP, however at any one time this will be limited to the bare minimum. COMPETITION FORMAT	<p><u>Men’s & Women’s Artistic Gymnastics</u></p> <p>The maximum delegation of athletes is five (5+1 reserve) in total for MAG and five (5+1 reserve) in total for WAG. Federations are eligible to send individuals (1-2 gymnasts) to compete for World Championships qualification. These athletes can compete in the Oceania Continental Championships.</p> <p>Team Competition</p> <p>Federations can enter up to 5 Senior International athletes in a team. Up to 4 athletes can compete on an apparatus, with the top 3 scores to contribute to the Team score</p>																		

	<p>World Championships Quota Places – ART Mention must be made that these Oceania Continental Championship will serve as qualifier event for the Artistic Gymnastics World Championships Liverpool 2022. Clarification must also be made that the AA gymnast and teams will qualify for Liverpool 2022 in accordance with the results of the Qualifications.</p> <p><u>Rhythmic Gymnastics</u> The maximum delegation of athletes is three (3+1 reserve) in total for RG. These athletes can compete in the Oceania Continental Championships.</p> <p>Team Competition Federations can enter up to 3 Senior International Individual athletes. Up to 3 athletes can compete on any apparatus, with the top 2 scores per apparatus (8 scores total) to contribute to the Team score.</p> <p>World Championship Quota Places - RG The Oceania Continental Individual Quota place (2-3 gymnasts) will be allocated to the Federation with the highest Team All-Around score. The Oceania Continental Individual Quota place (1 individual) will be allocated to the federation who did not qualify the Quota place for 2-3 Individual gymnasts.</p>
