FEDERATIONS INVITED	The Pan American Gymnastics Union invites all Federations affiliated to the PAGU and the FIG and which are up to date in their obligations.
AGE LIMITS	Senior 17 years and older* Junior 13-16 years old* *Ages as of December 31, 2022 All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.
QUALIFICATION FOR OTHER EVENTS	This Championship will serve as qualifier event for the following competition: Central American and Caribbean Sport Games San Salvador 2023.
JUDGES AND JURIES	All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline. Each Federation may register a maximum of 2 judges on each competition where is registered (TRA, DMT, TUM). The fine for not registering at least one judge in the respective competition is USD\$1,000.00. Federations with a PAGU TC Member can register that Member in addition to their official judges. The fines for not registering the required number of judges must be paid to PAGU by April 26, 2022 at the latest and it does not apply to those Federations that do not have FIG brevet judges in the respective competition (TRA, DMT, TUM) and that this is the first cycle in which they participate in PAGU competitions. The National Federation must inform PAGU at the time of the definitive

The cost of the accreditation for additional Delegation Members is **USD\$100.00** per person and must be paid to the LOC by **April 26, 2022** at the latest.

Only the following persons can receive an additional accreditation: Coach (as per PAGU TR), Doctor, Physiotherapist, Team Manager.

The accreditation of a third judge different from the TC Member has no cost.

Requirements for the photos:

- File format: JPEG
- Dimensions: min 210 x 270 pixels; max 420 x 540 pixels
- 3.5 cm width x 4.5 cm high
- File size: no more than 1 MB
- White background

Each document must be identified with the Country Code, Last name, First Name, Competition (TRI, TRS, DMT, TUM), category and function of each member.

This documentation must be sent no later than <u>May 26, 2022</u>. In case of not sending the photograph as requested, the Local Organizing Committee can take the photograph during the registration and will have an additional cost of **USD\$10.00** for each one.

In case of theft or loss of accreditation, it must be informed immediately to the Local Organization Committee for the cancellation of the accreditation. The replacement of stolen or lost accreditation will cost **USD\$50.00** to be covered by the accreditation holder.

Accreditation will be distributed upon arrival at the registration desk. More information on the access zones for each accreditation will be given in the Work Plan.

MEDICAL SERVICES	The Local Organizing Committee will provide first aid services and ambulance at the competition and training sites during the official activities.
COVID-19	All participants will take a COVID-19 test upon arrival to the official hotels and must stay in their rooms until the results of the tests are ready. During the trainings and competition periods all participants are allowed to circulate only in the assigned sport venues, as well as in the official hotels.
	Besides the medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible. The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible, and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout. Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and must keep a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.





	Additional information will be included in the Work Plan that will be sent to the Federations prior to the event.
VISA	Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Brazil Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Brazil. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before May 26, 2022 to the LOC.
	The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.
INSURANCE	The host Federation, the LOC, the PAGU and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.
	The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.
	Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. Please also refer to https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-

	The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance, no later than May 26, 2022 .
	The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: USD\$60.00 per person for the official days of the event, for those who request it by <u>May 26</u> . After this date the cost will be USD\$80.00 per person for the official days of the event.
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The invited participating Federations must pay for the international travel costs of their delegation members.

	The travel itinerary form must be returned to the LOC by May 26, 2022.
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	Local transportation will be offered to and from the airport, provided that the delegations stay in one of the official hotels and book their accommodation through the Local Organizing Committee.
	The Local Organizing Committee will provide local transportation from the airport to the hotel and vice versa, only on the official arrival day of <u>Thursday June 23</u> and on the official departure day of





of <u>USD\$30.00</u> per person per way (airport-hotel or hotel-airport). The request must be submitted and paid no later than <u>May 26, 2022</u>.

The Local Organizing Committee will provide transportation from the official hotels to the competition and training facilities and vice versa, for all members of the delegation duly accredited and according to the official program of activities, provided that the delegation stays in one of the official hotels and book its accommodation through the Local Organizing Committee.
