5. WELCOME – OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

- The delegations will be welcomed on behalf of the Organizing Committee upon arrival in RIMINI at the accreditation desk at the Competition Hall. In case of late arrival delegations will be accompanied directly to the hotel and the accreditation procedure will be carried out the morning after.
- The official language of this world cup is English. Announcements will be made in Italian and English only. The Work Plan and all other documents are available in English only.

6. ACCREDITATION

- Accreditation will take place at the accreditation desk upon arrival. Accreditation desk will be available on May 24 from 3pm to 7 pm and on May 25 and 26 from 8 am to 6 pm.
- At the moment of accreditation Heads of Delegation are required to verify the names of their entire delegation and the accommodation requirements. They have to pay any outstanding amounts due to the OC and / or the FIG, provide their confirmation of insurance and check their national anthem and national flag. They are also asked to provide bank details to be used to pay the money prize for the awarded gymnasts.
- HOD are requested to provide a valid phone number (working in Italy) and e-mail address. These contact details will be used during and after the competition to send to delegations any relevant information.
- As far as the number of accreditations per country is concerned, the FIG Rules and the Directives will be strictly applied.
- All delegation members will receive an accreditation ID Card. The accreditation ID Card is personal, non transferable and compulsory to get access to the training and competition hall, functions, and the bus system. All participants and officials are required to wear the ID Cards at all times.

7. NATIONAL FLAG AND ANTHEM

Delegations will be requested to check their national anthem and their national flag upon accreditation.

8. HOTELS / MEALS – INFORMATION

- All delegations will receive the hotel details before arrival by email.
- Breakfast will be served in the respective hotels from 7.00 to 10.00 am
- Lunch and Dinner will be served at competition venue from 11.30 to 15.00 and from 18.30 to 21.30.
- Please note that the Organizing Committee is not liable for any damages in the hotel rooms, costs for mini-bars, pay-TV or the like. This is the responsibility of each delegation.
- Please note that the latest check-out time is 10.00h at the day of departure.

9. LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

- The Organizing Committee will provide shuttle bus transportation between airports, railways station, hotels and competition venue between May 24th and May 29th for arrival/departure, training and competition. Shuttle bus from/to Hotel and Venue will be on regular bases. A detailed schedule will be handed in to delegation upon arrival and will be available at hotels and the Competition Hall. The transport is to the sole use of the delegations, which has booked their accommodation through the OC.
- While travelling on busses all participants are requested to:

11. ORIENTATION MEETING

- The Orientation Meeting will take place Thursday, May 26th at 2pm in the Meeting Room Mimosa at the Venue.
- The orientation meeting is **compulsory for all Heads of Delegation**.
- At this meeting all information concerning the detailed organization of the World Cup will be given by the Organizing Committee and the FIG. **The meeting will be held in English only.**

12. DRAWING OF LOTS

- The draw for the starting order for the Qualification Rounds was done beforehand at the FIG headquarters.
- Definitive starting order will be established and distributed by email to the delegations directly following the Orientation Meeting.
- Semifinals and finals starting order will be established by draw and communicate to the delegations after qualifications and semifinals.

13. EQUIPMENT

- Twelve trampolines, two DMT and two Tumbling tracks will be used during competition as per apparatus list published on FIG website.

14. MUSIC

- The organizing committee would like to point out that **during the competition**, background music will be played at a low volume. Please let your gymnasts know this in advance.

15. JUDGES INSTRUCTION AND MEETING

- The judges' instruction, which is **compulsory for all judges**, will take place on Thursday 26th at 3 pm in the Meeting Room Mimosa at the Venue. Please note that the judges' instruction will be held in English only. Judges who don't participate in the judges' instruction may not be authorized to judge and their respective federations may face a penalty fee of up to 2.000 CHF.
- During the meeting judges will be requested to provide a valid phone number (working in Italy) to receive any relevant information during the competition.

16. DRAWING OF LOTS FOR JUDGES

- The judges will be drawn after the judges' instruction on Thursday 26th from those that were put forward by the federations. Judges must be duly licensed (valid FIG license with the appropriate requested category).

18. PUBLICATION OF THE SCORES

- A detailed list of results, including judges' marks, will be sent to National federations and to the Heads of Delegation after the finals. During the competition, all results will be published in the venue and published on the following web-site www.gymresult.it

19. NO SMOKING POLICY

- Please note that it is strictly forbidden to smoke in the venue complex (including toilets and changing rooms) and hotels.

20. MEDICAL SERVICES

- On May 25th, 26th, 27th and 28th the Organizing Committee will provide medical services and an ambulance will be at the Competition Hall.

21. DOPING CONTROL

- Doping controls may be made during the World Cup - as per the FIG, IOC and WADA regulations - by the Italian Gymnastics Federation. The doping controls can take place during training and / or competition.

22. MARCH IN

- The competitors are asked to assemble in the assembly area 5 minutes prior to each competition. The athletes are asked to always wear the competition dress and FFP2 face mask.

23. WARM UP

- Immediately prior to the **Qualifying Round, Semifinals** and **Finals** each competitor/pair will be allowed **45 seconds** of warm-up on the competition apparatus.

24. COMPETITION ATTIRE

- The competition dress is as per Code of Points.

25. MAGNESIUM CARBONATE / LIQUID CHALK

- **Gymnasts who are used to use magnesium are requested to have their own magnesium, in a plastic bag or box, or liquid chalk.**

26. VIDEO RECORDING

- All routines will be recorded.

27. AWARD CEREMONIES AND PRIZE MONEY

27.1 AWARD CEREMONIES

- The award ceremonies will take place immediately after the last final in the same order of the Finals.
- Only the medal winners are invited to participate. They must wear according to FIG rules.

27.2 PRIZE MONEY

- Prize money will be given as below.

ANNEX 1

COVID RULES IN ITALY

COVID rules and regulation issued by Italian Ministry of Health for entering the Italian territory and for Sports Events, which are different from the ones to enter the Country, will change from May the 1st 2022.

RULES TO TAKE PART IN A SPORT EVENT

All participant to the event (accredited person) need to wear an FFP2 mask at all time in the venue, but for gymnasts performing, and on transports (event bus but also public transport).
Vaccination is no longer requested to take part in sport events in any function.

RULES TO ENTER ITALY

As of 1st of May 2022 Passenger Locator Form won't be requested anymore.

Regardless of the country of entry into Italy, **the traveller will be still required to present simultaneously** to the carrier and to whoever is in charge of checking:

- the [COVID-19 Green Certificate](#) or other [equivalent certificate](#) which must state one of the following conditions:
- **completion of the primary vaccination series or booster dose** according to the vaccination plans of the countries of release with vaccines authorized by the European Medical Agency (primary series validity 9 months and booster dose without predefined limit)
- **recovery from SARS-CoV-2 infection** (valid for 180 days from positive swab test)
- **recovery after the administration of** the first dose of vaccine or at the end of the primary vaccination series or following the administration of the relevant booster dose
- **rapid antigen or molecular swab test**, respectively within 48 or 72 hours before entry into Italy.

Covid-19 green certificates of successful vaccination are accepted in one of the following languages: Italian, English, French, Spanish or German. If submitted in another language, they must be accompanied by a sworn translation into Italian. Foreign certifications of recovery must be accompanied by a sworn translation into Italian.

As per rules and regulation to enter Italy we suggest all delegation to keep an eye on <https://www.salute.gov.it/portale/nuovocoronavirus/homeNuovoCoronavirus.jsp?lingua=english> where all update and changes are regularly issued.

COVID POSITIVE PERSON MANAGEMENT

People who are tested positive with a swab test (PCR or antigenic) needs to be isolated as follows:

- **At least 10 days** from 1st positive test, last three days should be without symptoms (but for sense of taste and smell).
- **Isolation days are reduced to 7** for those who have received the booster and those who had two vaccine shots no more than 120 days before the positive test.
- Isolation ends only after being tested negative with a swab test (PCR or antigenic). If still positive to the swab test but with no symptoms for at least 7 days (but for sense of taste and smell) the isolation can **be ended after 21 days**.

Close Contact

- Those who had close contact with a someone tested positive need to self monitor her/his health status and wear an FFP2 mask at all times, when in close spaces or with other people, for 10 days after the close contact.
- If during the self monitoring period any symptom occurs it is needed to do a swab test, to be repeated in case of negative result but persisting symptoms, after 5 days.
