FEDERATIONS INVITED	<p>The Organizing Member Federation will invite all AGU Member Federations in good standing.</p> <p>Federations which have not fulfilled their annual membership fees towards the AGU and the FIG and not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Organising Committee will not be allowed to participate in the Asian Championships.</p>
AGE LIMITS	Age limit for Senior RG: 16 years in the year of the competition
FIG LICENSE	All gymnasts must have a current valid FIG license until the end of the event.
ENTRY FEES	<p>The non- reimbursable cost for the Entry Fee are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50 USD per Individual gymnasts • 100 USD per Group <p>At the time of the Definitive Registration <u>23 April 2022</u>, 100% of the Entry Fee must be paid to the LOC.</p> <p>The entry fees should be paid by bank transfer onto the account of Gymnastics Association of Thailand.</p>

MEDICAL SERVICES	The Organising Committee will provide a first medical aid service, a doctor and emergency medical transportation in the competition area.
COVID 19	<p>All participants will take a COVID-19 test upon arrival to the official hotel and must stay in their rooms until the result of the tests are ready.</p> <p>During the trainings and competition periods all participants are allowed to circulate only in the assigned sport venues as well as in the official hotel.</p> <p>Besides the FIG medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also requires all the participants to follow the standards precautions.</p> <p>The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing mask or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p> <p>The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.</p> <p>Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p>
COVID 19 MEASURES	<p>Competitors arriving in Thailand must fully comply with the precautions that are specified in the Regulations of the Ministry of Health of the Kingdom of Thailand "To warn and prevent the spread of COVID-19 during the RG Competition."</p> <p>To enter Thailand, each member of the delegation must have a PCR test with a negative result to be provided to the medical service at the Thailand airport (done no later than 72 hours before arrival in Thailand)</p> <p>Before departure dates of the delegations the LOC will ensures the presence of a special laboratory for the PCR test at the Official Hotel for all representatives of the delegations.</p> <p>All members of the participating delegations must have with them a copy of passport. The cost of the PCR test per person is \$120. Payment is accepted in US currency only.</p> <p>Further specific guidelines will be communicated and implemented separately depending on the current local situation.</p>
DOPING CONTROLS	The Organizing Member Federation will provide at its own charge a minimum of 8 doping controls for Individual gymnasts and 5 for Groups. Anti-Doping Control Agency as well as Anti-Doping Control Laboratory will be nominated later.

VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Thailand Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Thailand. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before 23 April 2022 to the LOC.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p> <p>Please attach your scanned passport copies.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. Please also refer to https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges. The LOC will verify the insurance coverage upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). The insurance must be valid at least starting from the arrival day of the delegation and must last for the delegations' entire stay</p> <p>Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federation own charge as follows: 15 USD per person/day.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 23 April 2022</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>Local transportation costs will be covered by the LOC. The LOC will take in charge transportation costs, for all accredited people, from the airport of Thailand to hotels, and from hotels to the competition hall only if hotel reservations are made through the LOC.</p>

While the Accommodation Form must be returned to the LOC by **23 April 2022** at the very latest, the Hotel rooms will be allocated on a “first come, first serve” basis.

The invited participating federations must pay for the accommodation expenses of their delegation members. The costs for the accommodations and meals must be paid to the LOC by **23 April 2022**.

ACCREDITATION

Accreditation of all delegations will take place at their arrival in Competition Hall.

Representatives of the organizing committee will provide accreditation, training schedules, bus schedule for all the delegates at the competition hall.

In return, each delegation is obliged to provide the representative of the organizing committee with the following copies of documents

- Passports of all members of the delegation
- CD with the national anthem
- 2 copies of CDs with music for the programs
- National flag (120x 2025 cm)
- Gymnasts/ Group music (CD”s) – 2 (one for competition, one for trainings)
- Air tickets of all members of the delegation;
- License of each gymnast;
- Certification of insurance for all delegation members covering illness (including COVID-19), accidents, repatriation.

Heads of delegation have to check names of their own delegation members, hotel reservation; they also have to affect all necessary payments.

In order to speed accreditation procedures, please send to the Organizing Committee a photo of each member of the delegation (in electronic format or passport photo) together with the nominative registration (**23 May 2022**).

If the photo has to be taken at the Accreditation because none has been sent within the deadline or not sent in the official requested format, there will be a charge of 10 USD for each photo taken at the accreditation desk.

FINAL BANQUET

-The LOC provides for the official delegation for Free of charge for all participants only if the hotel reservations are made through the LOC.

- All other persons willing to attend this Banquet will be entitled to do so, provided that a request will be send in writing to the LOC via the “Meals” Form and that the amount of \$50 per person will be paid in full to the LOC by **23 April 2022**.

JUDGES AND JURIES	<p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet for the respective discipline (RGI and/or RGG).</p> <p>The participating member federation should send one or two qualified judge for RGI and/or RGG events.</p> <p>The travel expenses and accommodation are to be borne by the participant Federations.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation will apply a fine of USD 1500 per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC) should a federation fail to bring the required number of judges. This fine must be paid to the LOC by 23 April 2022.</p>
