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COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>According to FIG TR 2022, the 2022 Asian Championship is a qualifying event for the World Championships. For details, see the FIG Art.5.1.1 Section 2 Qualifications Pathway to the World Championships..</p> <p>AA gymnasts and Teams will qualify for Liverpool 2022 in accordance with the results of the "Qualifications" phase which determines the Team Ranking and the AA Ranking</p> <p>The competitions will be conducted according to FIG's Technical Regulations 2022 including Section 2 for Artistic Gymnastics, Reg. 5.1, with the following modifications.</p> <p>The competition consists of Men's and Women's Team Finals, All-Around Finals and Apparatus Qualifications and Finals.</p> <p><u>Team Final, All-Around Final, Apparatus Qualifications</u></p> <p>Competition Day 1: MAG (FX,PH,SR) & WAG (VT,UB), Competition Day 2: MAG (VT,PB,HB) & WAG (BB,FX)</p> <p>Team and All-Around Finals will also serve as the qualifications for the Apparatus Finals. Team and All-Around Finals will be in two days. All the federations in good standing are entitled to participate either with a team of 3- 5 gymnasts (and 1 reserve) or with a maximum of 3 Individual gymnasts.</p> <p>Important: Member Federations with 3 individuals may be considered in the team ranking in the Qualification and may be in the ranking list for the Team Final provided they register as a team at the provisional and definitive entry registration</p>

 A Team shall be composed of a maximum of 5 gymnasts, 4 may compete on any single piece of apparatus and the 3 highest scores will be taken into account for the team total.
 For men, the competition consists of optional exercises on six apparatus.
 For women, the competition consists of optional exercises on four apparatus.

To qualify for the vault finals, two vaults are necessary. The qualifying score is based on the average of the two scores.
 Only the first vault will count for the Team and All-Around ranking.
 The total scores of the gymnasts, who perform on all the apparatus in competition will determine the All-Around rankings (with maximum 2 gymnasts per federation).
 The tie-breaking rules will be applied for the Team Final and the All-Around Final as defined in the FIG Technical Regulations, Art. 7, Section 2
 In the qualifications for the Apparatus Finals, in case of ties, the tie-breaking rules as defined in the FIG TR Art. 7, Section 2 will be applied

Apparatus Finals
 Competition Day 3: MAG (FX,PH,SR) & WAG (VT,UB),
 Competition Day 4: MAG (VT,PB,HB) &WAG (BB,FX)

The results of the finals determine the champion on each apparatus.
 The top eight gymnasts on each apparatus from the Apparatus Qualifications shall be qualified to participate in the Apparatus Finals (with maximum 2 gymnasts per Federation).
 In case of ties, the tie-breaking rules as defined in the FIG TR Art. 7, Section 2 will be applied

***Award Ceremonies**
 Award ceremonies will be held after each competition. These gymnasts are required to attend the Awards ceremonies.
 The medals will be granted to the top 3 gymnasts/teams from each competition according to the result rankings.
 In case of a tie at any place (i.e for gymnasts with the same final score), the tie-breaking rules as set up in the Technical Regulations, Section 2, shall be applied.

<p>JUDGES AND JURIES</p>	<p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet for their function with minimum Cat 3.</p> <p>The participating member federations must send two qualified judges for MAG if male gymnasts participate in the Team competition and one qualified MAG judge if participates in the Individual competition only. Likewise, the participating member federations must send two qualified judges for WAG if female gymnasts participate in the Team competition and one qualified WAG judge if participates in the Individual competition only.</p> <p>The travel expenses and accommodation are to be borne by the participant Federations.
