GYMNASTS' DRAWING OF LOTS PROCEDURES

Qualifications

General Principles:

- There are 6 Subdivisions for MAG and 10 Subdivisions for WAG, with:

Teams Groups:

- 24 groups for MAG (max. 1 Team per group)
- 24 groups for WAG (max. 1 Team per group)

All-Around gymnasts (AA) Groups:

- 10 groups for MAG (max. 4 AA per group)
- 14 groups for WAG (max. 4 AA in 7 groups and max. 3 AA in 7 groups).

Apparatus Specialists (AS) Groups:

- 2 groups for MAG (max. 4 AS per group)
- 2 groups for WAG (max. 4 AS per group).

- For MAG there must be:

- in each subdivision max. 4 Team groups.
- 5 subdivisions with 2 AA groups
- 1 subdivision with 2 AS groups.

- For WAG there must be:

- 5 subdivisions with 2 Team groups and 2 AA groups
- 4 subdivisions with 3 Team groups and 1 AA group
- 1 subdivision with 2 Team groups and 2 AS groups

- Once the requested numbers of groups, gymnasts per groups, and positions are distributed, the Subdivision, group, and position can no longer be considered

- No AA gymnast or AS may be added into a Team group

- The FIG, in consultation with the TC and the LOC reserves the right to apply adjustments to the draw and starting order should the Nominative Registrations received or the final number of participants at the time of the competition generate organizational problems

First step:

To draw the **Team groups**, **AS groups**, and **AA groups** into the Subdivisions and Apparatus

- To put the cards of countries with a Team in bowl 1
- To put the cards of the Subdivision # and the Apparatus in bowl 2.
- To draw alternately from bowl 1 and bowl 2 until all countries with a Team are distributed.
- To put the cards of the AS group # in bowl 1
- To draw alternately from bowl 1 and bowl 2 until the two AS group # are distributed. The AS group # must be distributed in the same subdivision
- To put the cards of the AA group # in bowl 1
- To draw alternately from bowl 1 and bowl 2 until all AA group # are distributed.

Second step:

To draw the countries with **AA gymnasts** into the AA group #

- To put the cards of countries with 2 AA gymnasts in bowl 1
- To put the cards of the AA group # in bowl 2
- To draw alternately from bowl 1 and bowl 2, until all countries with 2 AA gymnasts are distributed.
- To put the cards of countries with 1 AA gymnast in bowl 1
- To draw alternately from bowl 1 and bowl 2, until all countries with 1 AA gymnast are distributed

Third step:

To draw the **AS** by name into the AS group #

- To draw the AS group # for the first AS. The group # will then alternate for all subsequent AS whenever possible.
- To put the cards with AS qualified (if any) on 6 apparatus for MAG and (if any) 4 apparatus for WAG in bowl 1. The country with the highest number of other AS qualified will have priority over the other countries.
- To put the cards with the name of the Apparatus in bowl 2
- To put the cards with the AS starting positions in bowl 3
- To draw alternately from bowl 1, bowl 2, and bowl 3 to designate the AS first Apparatus and starting position. The AS starting positions for the next Apparatus will automatically be determined by moving the AS up one position each time for each rotation in Olympic apparatus order.
The draw for the other AS qualified from the same country will follow immediately and whenever possible, in the same group.
- To repeat the same procedure until all AS qualified on 6 apparatus for MAG and 4 apparatus for WAG are distributed.
- To apply the same procedure for the AS qualified on respectively (if any) 5, 4, 3, 2, and then 1 apparatus for MAG and respectively (if any) 3, 2, and the 1 apparatus for WAG whenever possible.

Note:

An AS competing last on an apparatus cannot not be drawn to compete first or second on the next apparatus.

Team Final

The teams ranked 1-8 after the Qualifications are seeded as identified in the Starting Order chart. The teams rotate from one event to another as per the Olympic apparatus order, as identified in the Working Order chart.

All-Around Final

The gymnasts ranked 1-24 after the Qualifications are seeded in Olympic apparatus order into one subdivision, as identified in the Starting Order chart. The individuals rotate from one apparatus to another as per the Olympic apparatus order, as identified in the Working Order chart.

Apparatus Finals

In order to establish the Working order on each apparatus, a draw is carried out, until the positions 1-8 are filled.

Podium Training and Training Groups

Podium Training and Training Groups follow the Qualifications' draw order by subdivision and apparatus.
