AGE LIMITS	Senior 17 years and older* Junior 13-16 years old* <i>*Ages as of December 31, 2022</i> All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.									
JUDGES AND JURIES	All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline. Each Federation may register a maximum of 1 judge. The fine for not registering at least one judge in the respective competition is USD\$1,200.00 . The fines for not registering the required number of judges must be paid to CONSUGI by July 6th, 2022 at the latest and it does not apply to those Federations that do not have FIG brevet judges in the respective competition (TRI) and that this is the first cycle in which they participate in CONSUGI competitions. The National Federation must inform CONSUGI at the time of the definitive registration (July 6th, 2022) to allow the appointment of invited neutral judges.

MEDICAL SERVICES	<p>The Local Organizing Committee will provide first aid services and ambulance at the competition and training sites during the official activities.</p>
COVID-19	<p>All participants will take a COVID-19 test upon arrival to the official hotels and must stay in their rooms until the results of the tests are ready.</p> <p>During the trainings and competition periods all participants are allowed to circulate only in the assigned sport venues, as well as in the official hotels. Besides the medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p> <p>The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible, and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.</p> <p>Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and must keep a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p> <p>Additional information will be included in the Work Plan that will be sent to the Federations prior to the event.</p>
VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Colombia Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Colombia. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before July 6th , 2022 to the LOC.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the</p>

	Delegation member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.												
INSURANCE	<p>The host Federation, the LOC, the CONSUGI and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance.</p> <p>Please also refer to https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medicalinsurance.php additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance, no later than August 6th, 2022.</p> <p>The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: USD\$60.00 per person for the official days of the event, for those who request it by August 6th.</p>
