PARTICIPATION	<p>The World Cup Competitions consist of Qualifications and Finals in all 5 categories.</p> <p><u>Participation in the Qualifications:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All competitors must take part in the qualifications. • In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for the World Championships shall be applied. Nevertheless the gymnasts not qualified for the finals and with same final score will receive the same World Cup points. <p><u>Participation in the Finals:</u></p> <p>Category A and B tournaments must offer a Final in all 5 categories.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The top 8 units with no more than 2 per NF/per category from the qualifications qualify for the Finals. They will have to start first. COVID-19	<p>As the COVID-19 situation is still under observation and unstable around the world, besides the FIG medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also still requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions.</p>

	<p>The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible.</p> <p>The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.</p> <p>Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible.</p> <p>There are no more regulations and or environment-specific policy regarding Covid 19 at this time.</p>				
SAFEGUARDING	<p>From the official date of arrival until the official day of departure of the event, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the opportunity to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment or abuse of any type or if they are worried or do not feel comfortable. Tariff sheets

The World Cup 2023 in Puurs will use «Acro Companion» to create all tariff sheets. These tariff sheets will be judged digitally in Real-Time.

For this reason, it is mandatory to use the tariff sheets provided by the LOC.

All tariff sheets have to be sent inside the Acro Companion platform (see also the work plan for detailed information) before the deadline.

Adaptations in elements can still be made until the day of arrival.

Music

Music will be uploaded together with the tariff sheets in Acro Companion.

During training and competition, the delegations must have a USB key with them for each exercise in .MP3 format (no back-up CD will be accepted). Competitors and coaches are responsible for all copies of their music.

- USB: the name of each music file has to contain the following information (all music can be collected on 1 USB):
 - Exercise (BAL, DYN, COM)
 - Qualification and/or Final (Q or F)
 - Country (abbreviation) + number (for example 'BEL1')
 - Age Group (11-17, 12-19, 13-20)
 - Category (MP – WP – MXP – MG – WG)

During the competition, all music will be played by computer only. It is the responsibility of each delegation to ensure that the correct music is played for the respective gymnasts/unit.
