ENTRY FEES	The entry fee for this event will be 50 €/each participating individual gymnast/junior team RGI and 200 € per Group, payable by 15.02.2023.								
ACCREDITATION	The members of every delegation get the accreditation by the first visit of the training or competition-hall at the accreditation-desk.								
COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>A: AA Senior gymnasts Individual: (hoop, ball, clubs, ribbon)</p> <p>B: Team Competition Junior gymnasts: The Federations participating with 2-4 gymnasts will join the Team Competition. They have to present 4 exercises according to the junior program (same format like in Junior World Championships). In a team competition, a gymnast may participate with 1-3 exercises. No more than 4 exercises can be executed per Federation (except host NF). The team result will be calculated based on all 4 presented exercises. If a NF participates with only 1 gymnast, she has to present an exercise with each of the 4 apparatus and can qualify with each apparatus for the Apparatus Finals. However, she won't be ranked in the team ranking and won't get a medal/certificate for AA.</p> <p>C: AA Senior Group: (5 hoops & 3 ribbons + 2 balls)</p> <p>D: AA Junior Group: (5 ropes & 5 balls)</p> <p>E: Apparatus Finals RGI Junior & Senior + RGG Junior & Senior Apparatus finals RGI: (4 apparatus) of the 8 best gymnasts from Qualification (max. 1 gymnast per federation) per apparatus. 2 gymnasts from the host country will be allowed into the Apparatus Finals. The organizer reserves the right to appoint one gymnast (out of these 2) to take part in every final.</p> <p>F: Apparatus finals RGG: (2 routines) of the best 6 groups from Qualification (max. 1 group per federation). If the host country is not qualified, the organizer reserves the right to give a wild card for them as additional group (6+1)</p>

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The transfer from Stuttgart airport/Stuttgart train station to the Hotel and back will be paid and organised by the LOC. The mentioned transfer can only be guaranteed if one of the following accommodations is booked via the LOC.</p>
