COMPETITIONS HEAD JUDGE	<p>The President of the Superior Jury will be: Mrs. Nuria Castaño Fernández, Cat 2 in RGI.</p>
SIZE OF THE DELEGATIONS	<p>Each delegation may consist:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Gymnasts according to the regulations of GP. * 1 coach * 1 judge

MEDICAL SERVICES	<p>The Organizing Committee will provide medical attention during trainings and competition</p>
COVID 19	<p>The FIG Medical Guidelines for FIG Competitions and Events are still effective and they should be used according to the situation with COVID-19 pandemic in your country. Considering the current situation as it is written in the guideline, it is the health situation in your country that prevails. "These guidelines can be adapted according to the health situation related to the COVID-19 pandemic in the host country and the city."</p>
VISA	<p>The Delegations should inquire about whether they need a visa to travel to Spain from their countries. The Organizing Committee will be pleased to provide each Delegation with an official invitation letter, as long as you have sent them before of February 6th, 2023. In the application form there should be included the position, full name, gender, date of birth, nationality and passport number, address, dates of arrival and departure of the members of the delegation and the city where the letter should be sent.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. Please also refer to https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges. The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. In such cases, the Organizing Committee will provide an insurance option to the Federations.</p>
