GYMNASTS' DRAWING OF LOTS PROCEDURES

We are pleased to hereby submit the procedures for the MAG and WAG gymnasts drawing of lots for the 2nd FIG Artistic Gymnastics Junior World Championship in Antalya (TUR).

Qualifications (which also serve as Team Award Ceremony)

General Principle: no individual gymnasts may be drawn in a "team group".

First step: to draw the individual gymnasts into the "mixed groups".

For MAG, there will be 6 "mixed groups" composed of 4 gymnasts

For WAG, there will be 2 "mixed groups" composed of 4 gymnasts and 4 "mixed groups" composed of 3 gymnasts

When a "mixed group" is full, the number for the "mixed group" will be taken out from the corresponding bowl.

- To put the cards with the names of countries with 1 gymnast in bowl #1
- To put the cards with the "mixed groups" numbers in bowl #2
- To draw alternately from bowl #1 and bowl #2, until all countries with 1 gymnast are assigned

Second step: to draw the "mixed groups" and "teams" into the subdivision number and apparatus

For MAG, there will be:

- 2 Subdivisions composed of 5 "team groups" (of 2 teams each), plus 1 "mixed group"
- 2 Subdivisions composed of 4 "team groups" (of 2 teams each), plus 2 "mixed groups"

For WAG, there will be 6 Subdivisions composed of 3 "team groups" (of 2 teams each), plus 1 "mixed group"

When a subdivision number and apparatus is full, it will be taken out from the corresponding bowl.

- To put the cards with the "mixed groups" numbers in bowl #1
- To put the cards indicating the subdivision number and apparatus in bowl #2
- To draw alternately from bowl #1 and bowl #2, until all "mixed groups" are assigned.
- To put the cards with the names of the countries with a "team" in bowl #1
- To draw alternately from bowl #1 and bowl #2 (which contains the remaining subdivision number and apparatus cards), until all "teams" are assigned.

All-Around Final

The gymnasts ranked 1-24 after the Qualifications are seeded in Olympic apparatus order into one subdivision, as identified in the Starting Order chart. The individuals rotate from one apparatus to another as per the Olympic apparatus order, as identified in the Working Order chart.

Apparatus Finals

In order to establish the Working order on each apparatus, a draw is carried out, until the positions 1-8 are filled.

Podium Training and Training Groups

Podium Training and Training Groups follow the Qualifications' draw order by subdivision and apparatus.
