ACCREDITATION	<p>Participating delegation members as well as FIG, UAG representatives, judges and officials must send electronic ID colour high resolution photographs and electronic colour copy of passports, to the LOC via email within the deadline set for the <b>nominative registration of 06 February 2023</b>.</p> <p>Gymnasts' names / ages / nationality will be verified with a passport check at accreditation. The LOC will check the validity of the gymnast's licences.</p> <p>Gymnasts' FIG licence number and copy of WADA certificate, which must <b>BOTH</b> be valid until the end of the competition must be emailed to the LOC no later than the deadline set for the <b>nominative registration of 06 February 2023</b>.</p> <p>Participating gymnasts without valid FIG licence and WADA certificate will <b>NOT</b> be accredited.</p> <p>In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.</p>																	
EVENT FORMAT	<p>The African Championships will comprise of qualifications and finals and will determine winners in each category:</p> <p>Trampoline/</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Individual, Male and Female; Junior and Senior</li><li>Syncho, Male and Female; Junior and Senior</li><li>For Senior and Junior Team winners: Where a team constitutes four or three members the three highest scores from Individual Qualification for both exercises will be added together to get the team score to determine the ranking and placement.</li></ol>

VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Moroccan Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Morocco (MAR). The Organizing Committee can assist delegation members through their federations with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made in writing via email on or before <b>26 January 2023</b> to the LOC.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the delegation member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>	
JUDGES AND JURIES	<p>The number of judges each participating federation must provide will be determined following receipt of the Definitive registrations, which must be submitted no later than <b>09<sup>th</sup> January 2023</b>. Federations will be required to provide judges in each discipline where the federation has participants.</p> <p><b>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet licence at the time of the event as well as send in their Judges FIG licence number.</b></p>	
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance.
