



## PARIS 2024 OLYMPIC GAMES SELECTION PROCEDURES FOR RHYTHMIC JUDGES

### Order of selection

- Additional Superior Jury Member (SJ)
- Difficulty Body judges (DB)
- Difficulty Apparatus judges (DA)
- Artistry judges (A) and Execution judges (E) alternating, as per the judges' ranking in A and E
- Reserve judges (R)

### Rules for all nominated judges

- No current National Federation (NF) President or Secretary General at time of nomination through the end of the 2024 Paris Olympic Games
- Maximum 1 judge per NF
- NF with a SJ cannot have a judge in the panel
- No Warning Letter or Sanction from the Gymnastics Ethics Foundation during current cycle
- No judges who are currently under a disciplinary procedure

### Additional Superior Jury member(s)

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Category 1 in RGI and RGG only</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Same principle as described below for DB, DA, A, E judges for the positions DB SJ, DA SJ, A SJ, E SJ, depending on the function needed (not determined at the time of writing these criteria)</li></ul>

### Difficulty Body (DB) Judges

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Category 1 in RGI and RGG only</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <u>Experience 1</u>: must have judged a minimum of 2 RGI competitions + 2 RGG competitions from the events included in the selection procedure</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <u>Experience 2</u>: must have served as a DB judge or a DB SJ at least in one phase of: one RGI WCH/JWCH + one RGG WCH/JWCH + one additional RGI competition + one additional RGG competition, all from the events included in the selection procedure</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In the case there are not enough judges with the experience mentioned under Experience 1 and Experience 2, refer to the Contingency procedure</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Draw among all judges fulfilling these criteria</li></ul>

### Difficulty Apparatus Judges (DA)

Same principle is applied but with the experience in DA instead of DB.

## **Contingency valid for DB and DA**

In the case there are not enough judges with the experience mentioned under Experience 1 and Experience 2, judges will be prioritized in the following order (example for DB):

- a. Judges that have served as a DB judge or a DB SJ at least in one phase of:
  - one RGI WCH/JWCH + one RGG WCH/JWCH + one additional competition (RGI or RGG)
- b. Judges that have served as a DB judge or a DB SJ at least in one phase of:
  - one RGI WCH/JWCH + one RGG WCH/JWCH + no additional competition
- c. Judges that have served as a DB judge or a DB SJ at least in one phase of:
  - one RGI WCH/JWCH or one RGG WCH/JWCH + one additional RGI competition + one additional RGG competition
- d. Judges that have served as a DB judge or a DB SJ at least in one phase of:
  - one RGI WCH/JWCH or one RGG WCH/JWCH + one additional competition (RGI or RGG)
- e. Judges that have served as a DB judge or a DB SJ at least in one phase of:
  - one RGI WCH/JWCH or one RGG WCH/JWCH + no additional

Experience mentioned above must be from the events included in the selection procedure.

## **Artistry (A) judges**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Category 1 or 2 in RGI and RGG (no initial priority based on category)</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <u>Experience 1</u>: must have judged a minimum of 2 RGI competitions + 2 RGG competitions from the events included in the selection procedure</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <u>Experience 2</u>: must have served as a A judge or a A SJ at least in one phase of: RGI WCH/JWCH + one RGG WCH/JWCH + one additional RGI competition + one additional RGG competition, all from the events included in the selection procedure</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The JEP overall accuracy score over all the events in the selection procedure, as long as it is above fair. No judges with a "Poor" grade in this overall report. Judges selected in rank order</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Only Judges who have shown integrity and who have no excessive bias judging during the entire current Olympic Cycle according to JEP analysis in the overall report</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Judges for A and E will be selected from the respective ranking lists by alternation: First, the top-ranked eligible Artistry judge is selected, then the top-ranked eligible Execution judge is selected, then the next-ranked eligible Artistry judge is selected, and so on</li></ul>

## **Execution (E) judges**

Same principle will be applied as for A but with the experience and evaluation in E instead of A.

## **Reserve (R) judges**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Category 1 or 2 in RGI and RGG (priority will be given to Category 1 both in RGI and RGG if there are remaining Category 1 not already drawn/nominated)</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <u>Experience 1</u>: must have judged a minimum of 2 RGI competitions + 2 RGG competitions from the events included in the selection procedure</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <u>Experience 2</u>: must have served as a judge (except Time and Line) or a SJ at least in one phase of: one RGI WCH/JWCH + one RGG WCH/JWCH + one additional RGI competition + one additional RGG competition, all from the events included in the selection procedure</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The JEP overall accuracy score over all the events in the selection procedure will be used to select 2 times the number of requested judges, followed by a random draw</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Guaranteed to actively judge a minimum of one phase at the 2024 Paris OG</li></ul>

### **Special provision for replacement of SJ members**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In the case a SJ must be replaced before the selection of the judges is made:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The replacement judge will be nominated as per the general criteria and the criteria mentioned under "Additional Superior Jury member(s)" for the respective function(s)</li></ul></li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In the case a SJ must be replaced after the selection of the judges is made:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The judge nominated for the respective position in the judges' panel will replace the missing SJ</li><li>- The Reserve judge Nr 1 will take the place of the replacement judge</li></ul></li></ul>

### **Quota Numbers for Judges**
