### **GYMNASTS' DRAWING OF LOTS PROCEDURES**

We are pleased to provide you with the drawing of lots procedures for Individuals and Groups competing at the 2<sup>nd</sup> FIG Rhythmic Gymnastics Junior World Championship in Cluj-Napoca (ROU).

#### General principles for Individual and for Group competitions:

The order of the apparatus for Individuals and Groups are pre-defined, Hoop and Ball, Clubs and Ribbon for RGI and 5 Ropes and 5 Balls for RGG.

- Random drawing of lots will be carried out by computer for Qualifications and Apparatus Finals
- Drawing of lots will be conducted in the following order of priority:
  1. Individual Qualification
  2. Individual Apparatus Finals
  3. Group All-Around Competition
  4. Group Finals

#### **Individual Competitions – Qualifications**

---

General principles:

- 1) One drawing of lots will be conducted with all participating National Federations (NFs)
- 2) NF drawn 1 will be on Hoop, NF drawn 2 will be on Ball, NF drawn 3 will be on Hoop, NF drawn 4 will be on Ball etc, until all NFs have a position
- 3) The drawing of lots will be then divided into four (4) equal (if possible, depending on the final total number of NFs) sub-groups (A, B, C and D)

#### **Day 1:**

- Sub-group A will start the competition followed by groups B, C, and D
- When all NFs from sub-group A have their gymnast performed their first apparatus alternately Hoop and Ball, NFs will keep the same order for their gymnast to perform the second apparatus alternately Ball and Hoop
- Same principle for sub-groups B, C and D.

#### **Day 2:**

- NFs remain in their respective groups (A, B, C or D) but the starting order within each group will be determined by a new drawing of lots
- When all NFs from sub-group A have their gymnast performed their first apparatus (alternately Clubs and Ribbon), NFs will keep the same order for their gymnast to perform the second apparatus (alternately Ribbon and Clubs)
- Same principle for sub-groups B, C and D.

## **Individuals - Apparatus Finals**

---

The starting order for each Apparatus Final will be determined by four (4) different drawing of lots.

### **Group All-Around Competitions**

General principles:

- 1) One drawing of lots will be conducted with all NFs
- 2) NFs will be allocated alternately on 5 Ropes (NF drawn 1) and 5 Balls (NF drawn 2) etc, until all NFs have a position
- 3) Each Group will perform one routine per day.

#### **Day 1:**

- NFs will compete in the order of the drawing of lots alternately 5 Ropes and 5 Balls

#### **Day 2:**

- A new drawing of lots will be conducted within the NFs having already performed 5 Balls to determine the starting order of 5 Ropes,
- A new drawing of lots will be conducted within the NFs having already performed 5 Ropes to determine the starting order of 5 Balls

## **Group Apparatus Finals**

---

The starting order for each Apparatus Final will be determined by two (2) different drawing of lots.
