The Technical Delegate, accompanied by the Technician of the Apparatus Manufacturer will proceed to the apparatus control in the competition hall, warm-up hall and training hall(s) prior to training and competition. All floors must be set up correctly and the RG competition floors in the different halls must be identical.

JUDGES AND JUDGES’ PANELS	For the composition of the Judges’ Panels, please refer to the Code of Points in force at the time of the event.																																								

	For the Judges' categories, please refer to the General Judges' rules in force at the time of the event. Not more than one judge per Federation per panel will be permitted. Priority will be given to the highest categories. The Judges' Panels are set up by a draw from the judges present at the event. The draw will be directed by the FIG Technical Delegate on site. The participating member federations must send minimum one qualified judge if they participate with individual gymnast(s) and one qualified judge if they participate with a group. Those judges can be the same or different The Organizing Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, or not sufficient cat. 1 and 2 judges, the Organizing Member Federation must propose to the FIG for prior approval of the Technical Delegate the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation. Such invitation must be made through the respective Member Federation. Should the Organizing Member Federation fail to propose names for additional judges, the FIG Office in consultation with the Technical Delegate concerned will invite these judges at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation. The Organizing Member Federation will apply a fine of CHF 2'000 per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC by 17 March 2023 should a federation fail to bring the required number of judges or judges without the requested qualification (brevet).															
COACHES	No coaches will be accepted in this World Cup without a valid coach-sport profile at the deadline of the Nominative Registration. In order to be considered, the coach-sport profile (including all relevant documents) must be submitted in FIG Database on 03 March 2023 at the very latest (two weeks prior to the deadline for Nominative Registration).															
FIG TECHNICAL DELEGATE	The FIG Technical Delegate will be proposed by the FIG RG TC. He/she will serve as President of the Superior Jury.

DRAWING OF LOTS	The gymnasts' drawing of lots will take place at the FIG Headquarters in Lausanne (SUI) on Friday 31 March 2023. Registrations and payments made after the gymnasts' drawing of lots will not be accepted and the Delegations will not be authorized to participate.															

ENTRY FEES!	The non-reimbursable cost for the Entry Fee is: • 50 USD per Individual gymnast • 100 USD per Group The entry fee should be paid by bank transfer onto the account of Uzbekistan Gymnastics Federation.
ACCOMMODATION	The hotel prices are per room per night, include breakfast and city taxes are as follows: Category 1 Hotel ***** 200 USD (single room, breakfast included) 280 USD (double room, breakfast included) Category 2 Hotel *** 150 USD (single room, breakfast included) 180 USD (double room, breakfast included) The “low cost” Hotel: 120 USD (double room, breakfast not included) 150 USD (triple room, breakfast not included) There are no any single rooms in “low cost” hotel. The prices charged for the hotel rooms cannot exceed the usual hotel rates. The invited participating federations must pay for the accommodation expenses of their delegation members, except for the below mentioned gymnasts for whom accommodation will be paid by the LOC (from the official arrival day to the official departure day): • The top three (3) gymnasts in the All-Around ranking from the previous World Championships present at the event • The top three (3) Groups in the All-Around ranking from the previous World Championships present at the event The Organizing member Federation shall determine the hotel at its discretion, but may not chose the “low cost” category hotel for the above-mentioned gymnasts. The 100% costs for the accommodations must be paid to the LOC by 17 March 2023. While the Accommodation Form must be returned to the LOC by 14 February 2023 at the very latest, the Hotel rooms will be allocated on a “first come, first serve” basis. Fine for the late accommodation form delivery (after 14 February 2023): \$200.00 to be paid for the LOC. After the payment deadline (17 March 2023) an accommodation change request has to be submitted to the LOC in written form. A fee \$20.00 then will be charged per change request. Fees for changes request are in addition of cancellation form. After receiving your Accommodation form the LOC will contact you to provide the contract and invoice for payment.

	In case the event is cancelled due to force-major circumstances or in case your Delegation cannot come due to the travel restrictions imposed by the global health situation, all costs will be reimbursed with the exception of costs arising for LOC from the reimbursement of the money.
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The invited participating federations must pay for the international travel costs of their delegation members. The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 01 April 2023 .
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	Local transportation costs will be covered by the LOC. The LOC will take in charge transportation costs, for all accredited people, from the airport of Tashkent to official hotels and back, from official hotels to Gymnastics Sport Palace and back, only if hotel reservations are made through the LOC.

The LOC will apply for the visa support letter to the Ministry of foreign affairs, after all arrangements LOC will send you the letter which should be printed and provided in the Uzbekistan Embassy in your country. If there is no the Uzbekistan Embassy or Consulate in your country you will get visa in Tashkent airport upon arrival, in this case please indicate this in the online visa application form.
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. Please also refer to https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges. If the note has not been sent in advance to the LOC (which is strongly recommended), the LOC will verify the insurance coverage upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). The insurance must be valid at least starting from the arrival day of the delegation and must last for the delegations' entire stay. Delegation members with insufficient insurance coverage must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance coverage at the Federations own charge as follows: 10 USD per person/day.
ACCREDITATION	In order to accelerate accreditation procedures, please upload the necessary information on the website: www.competition.uz. After the deadline of the nominative registrations the LOC will send the pin-code to each participating Federation. Heads of Delegations have to check information about their own delegation as regards of hotel reservations and payments.

	The head of delegation will need to bring: - Passports for all delegation members - Insurance for all Delegation members - 2 copies of CDs with music for the programs - National flag (120 x 205 cm) - CD with national anthem - Gymnasts / Groups music (CD's) – 2 (one for competition, one for trainings) In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the safeguarding Officer operations plan upon accreditation.
FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS	Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the FIG (e.g. annual membership fees, unpaid invoices, etc.) or the LOC may not be allowed to participate in this World Cup. Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the LOC by the given deadline in the Invitation/Directives may still have the possibility to participate, but the LOC will not guarantee the hotel booking, meals and local transportation. Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Organizing Member federations upon arrival will not be accredited.
BANK ACCOUNT INFORMATION!	Bank details as well as the contract for payment will be sent to NFs by the LOC after receiving accommodation and meals forms from the participating Federations. The participating Federations are responsible for covering all bank fees in connection with the bank transfers.
TIE BREAKING RULES	In case of a tie at any place, the tie breaking rules for the RG World Championships as outlined in the current FIG Technical Regulation Section 3 shall be applied. After application, if there is still a tie: For participation to the Apparatus Final (Individual) and Final Routine (Group): • The tied gymnasts / groups will proceed to the final For Prize money: • The prize money of the tied ranks will be added and divided by the number of ties. For World Cup Points: • The World Cup points of the tied ranks will be added and divided by the number of ties. For Yearly winner: • The number of ranks of the three counting competitions achieved by the respective gymnast/group will be added and the gymnast/group with the lowest total will prevail. • If there is still a tie, the total score of the counting routines will be added and the gymnast/group with the highest total will prevail. • If there is still a tie, the total execution score of the counting routines will be added and the gymnast/group with the highest total execution score will prevail

For the Groups All-Around and Routine Ranking Lists, World Cup Points are assigned to the **Federation**. The Groups are listed **by Federation** only.

YEARLY WINNER

The yearly winner of the World Cup Series is the Individual Gymnasts/Groups with the highest number of points of each of the World Cup Series Ranking List of the respective year after the last event of the series, counting the best results (maximum 3, regardless of the number of competitions the gymnast participated in).

	A special award ceremony will be held at the last World Cup Competition of the year in which the winning gymnasts/groups shall receive a Cup. The 3 best Individual/Groups will receive an additional prize money paid by FIG.

MEDICAL SERVICES	The LOC will provide a first medical aid service, a doctor and emergency medical transportation in the competition area and in the training areas.
COVID 19	As the COVID-19 situation is still under observation and unstable around the world, besides the FIG medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also still requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions. The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible. The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout. Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible. Competitors arriving in Uzbekistan must fully comply with the precautions that are specified in the Regulations of the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Uzbekistan "To warn and prevent the spread of COVID-19 during the RG Competition". To enter Uzbekistan, each member of the delegation must have a PCR test with a negative result to be provided to the medical service at the airport of Tashkent (done no later than 72 hours before arrival in Uzbekistan). The delegation doctor or one of the delegation representatives must join the personal number of the LOC head doctor (will be nominated) on the WhatsApp or Telegram at (number will be provided) or by email uzb_gym@mail.ru: - For the request of PCR tests on the day of arrival and the day of departure of the delegation. Before departure dates of the delegations the LOC will ensure the presence of a special laboratory for the PCR test, on the territory of the Gymnastics Federation of Uzbekistan or Official Hotels for all representatives of the delegations. All participants will have to go through quick test before podium training to make sure that infection will not spread in training and competition halls. All necessary preparations will be provided by LOC. The cost of quick test is \$ 25 per person. All members of participating delegations must have with them a copy of passport. The cost of a PCR test per person is \$40. Payment is accepted in cash.

DOPING CONTROLS	Anti-doping controls will be organised by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of the FIG and according to the WADA Code, Standards and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.

SCORING, RESULT SERVICE AND VIDEO CONTROL	The Organising Member Federation must provide a scoring and result service with outputs as provided by the official scorer / data handling provider at FIG World Championships, including a high-quality video system with sound which allows the recording, storage and provision of compilation of the recorded images for the Difficulty Judges, the Superior Jury and the President of the Superior Jury. The videos must be sent to the FIG office within one week after the competition. Throughout the competition, the system must be able to redisplay in real time, normal speed, slow motion or fixed image, the different sequences and the registered scores of every exercise performed for the Technical Delegate. The scoring and result system must include a TV graphics generator. The presentation of the TV graphics on the international signal must be identical to those used at the FIG World Championships.
