SIZE OF THE DELEGATIONS	Each delegation may consist: * Gymnasts according to the regulations of GP. * 1 coach 1 judge

ACCREDITATIONS	Accreditations will be given to the delegations after arrival at the hotel. The head of delegation should present: > The passports of all members > Health insurance for all members > License FIG of each gymnast. A copy in USB of the music of each exercise. In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.
FORMAT	Individual classification All-around. Individual Senior. All gymnasts must compete with four apparatus (hoop, ball, clubs and ribbon)

MEDICAL SERVICES	The Organizing Committee will provide medical attention during trainings and competition
COVID 19 MEASURES	The LOC should follow local guidelines in management of COVID-19. The LOC must facilitate COVID-19 testing for delegations when it is required to have a negative test for return to their country
VISA	<p>The Delegations should inquire about whether they need a visa to travel to Spain from their countries.</p> <p>The Organizing Committee will be pleased to provide each Delegation with an official invitation letter, as long as you have sent them before a date to determine.</p> <p>In the application form there should be included the position, full name, gender, date of birth, nationality and passport number, address, dates of arrival and departure of the members of the delegation and the city where the letter should be sent.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. Please also refer to https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.</p> <p>In such cases, the Organizing Committee will provide an insurance option to the Federations.</p>
SAFEGUARDING	<p>From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable.</p> <p>The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site.</p> <p>In addition, posters of the “10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics”, the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will have to be displayed in several locations, including training and warm-up halls and public zones.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORT	<p>The Organizing Committee will offer to the members of delegations a free service of transport from / to Malaga Airport or to Maria Zambrano Station, as well as from the official hotel to venue of the competition (and vice versa).</p> <p>The Travel Form must be sent to the Organizing Committee before a date to be determined</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORT	The Organizing Committee will offer to the participants free transport from the official hotel to the venue of the competition (and vice versa).
