Each pair and group perform one Balance and one Dynamic exercise. The exercise is composed of compulsory and optional elements. Ranking after the qualifications is determined by the sum of scores from the two Exercises: Balance and Dynamic. The top 8 proceed to a Final with not more than one from each federation in each category. If there are less than 12 entries to a category, only 6 will proceed to the Final.</p> <p>Final Marking starts from Zero. In the final, pairs and groups will present one exercise, as pre-determined by category, either Balance or Dynamic: Women's Pairs: Balance Mixed Pairs: Dynamic Men's Pairs: Balance Women's Groups: Dynamic Men's Groups: Balance</p>				

	<p>Competitors cannot participate in the Final without competing in both the Balance and Dynamic qualifying events. Each Pair and group perform one Combined exercise in the finals. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before 16 August 2023 to the LOC.</p> <p>The procedure of visa issuance is following: You need to fill in the online visa application form on the web site: http://evisa.mfa.uz/evisa_en/, save and send it to us along with the passport copy. The LOC will apply for the visa support letter to the Ministry of foreign affairs, after all arrangements LOC will send you the letter which should be printed and provided in the Uzbekistan Embassy in your country. If there is no the Uzbekistan Embassy or Consulate in your country you will get visa in Tashkent airport upon arrival, in this case please indicate this in the online visa application form.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance.
