<b>JUDGES AND JURIES</b>	Each delegation should send minimum one judges by discipline. In case a delegation does not send one judges a fine is applicable in the value of <b>500€ for each missing judge.</b> The number of Judge's panels will be decided depending on the number of participating competitors and judges. The Juries will be set by a draw from the judges present at the event. The priority will be given to the judges of the highest category. All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline.
