FEDERATIONS INVITED	<p>The Organizing Member Federation will invite all AGU Member Federations in good standing.</p> <p>Federations which have not fulfilled their annual membership fees towards the AGU and the FIG and not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Organizing Committee will not be allowed to participate in the Asian Championships.</p>

FIG LICENSE	All gymnasts must have a valid FIG license until the end of the event.
ENTRY FEES	<p>Entry Fee</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50 USD per Individual gymnasts • 100 USD per Group <p>At the time of the Definitive Registration <u>15 Feb. 2024</u> 100% of the Entry Fee must be paid to the LOC.</p> <p>The entry fees should be paid by bank transfer onto the account of Uzbekistan Gymnastics Federation. Any bank charges will be shouldered by the delegation.</p>
COMPETITION FORMAT – JUNIOR	<p>Team Definition</p> <p>A Team consists of two (2) to four (4) individual gymnasts performing 4 RGI routines in total, and one (1) group performing 2 RGG routines.</p> <p>Participation with Individual General principles</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Each gymnast must perform at least one (1) routine. - Each NF has the right to choose the number of routines to be performed per its gymnast. - Each NF has the right to choose the apparatus to be performed per its gymnast. - The minimum number of routines per gymnast is 1, the maximum is 4 routines. - The maximum number of routines per NF is 4 in total, i.e., one (1) per apparatus. <p>Individual Qualification with Team:</p> <p>Each NF must participate with 2, 3 or 4 Individual gymnasts.</p> <p>Individual Qualification without Team:</p> <p>Each NF is entitled to participate with 1, 2, 3 or 4 Individual gymnast(s).</p> <p>Apparatus Final</p> <p>The best eight (8) gymnasts of the Qualifications on each of the 4 apparatus of the programme are designated to participate in the Individual Apparatus Finals, regardless of if they participate with or without a Team.</p> <p>Participation with Group</p> <p>Group All-Around Competition with Team:</p> <p>Each Group must present 1 routine with 5 Hoops and 1 routine with 5 Pairs of Clubs.</p> <p>Group All-Around Competition without Team:</p> <p>Each Group may present 1 routine with 5 Hoops and 1 routine with 5 Pairs of Clubs.</p> <p>A Group may perform 1 routine only but in that case is not eligible for the All-Around ranking</p> <p>Ranking or Team Ranking.</p>

	<p>Group All-Around Ranking: The All-Around Ranking is established by adding the two (2) results of the All-Around Competition.</p> <p>Apparatus Finals The best eight (8) Groups of the All-Around Competition of each apparatus are designated to participate in the Apparatus Final, regardless of if they participate with or without a Team.</p> <p>Team Ranking: The team ranking is established by adding the four (4) scores of the RGI Qualification and the two (2) scores of the RGG All-Around Competition.</p>

DOPING CONTROLS	Doping controls will be organised by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of the FIG and according to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), the international standards enacted by the World Anti-doping Agency (WADA) and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.																																				
COVID 19	The LOC should follow local guidelines in management of COVID-19.																																				

	The LOC must facilitate COVID-19 testing for delegations when it is required to have a negative test for return to their country.
VISA	<p>Please verify immediately via the link: https://mfa.uz/en/pages/visa-republic-uzb if a visa or e-visa is required for your travel to Uzbekistan.</p> <p>If you need e-visa to enter Uzbekistan, please follow the procedure on the link https://e-visa.gov.uz/main</p> <p>If you require visa, you need to fill in the online visa application form on the web site: http://evisa.mfa.uz/evisa_en/, save and send it to us along with the passport copy. The LOC will apply for the visa support letter to the Ministry of foreign affairs, after all arrangements LOC will send you the letter which should be printed and provided in the Uzbekistan Embassy in your country.</p> <p>If there is no the Uzbekistan Embassy or Consulate in your country you will get visa in Tashkent airport upon arrival, in this case please indicate this in the online visa application form.</p> <p>The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before 15 March, 2024 to the LOC.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. Please also refer to https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medicalinsurance.php for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges. If the note has not been sent in advance to the LOC (which is strongly recommended), the LOC will verify the insurance coverage upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy).</p> <p>The insurance must be valid at least starting from the arrival day of the delegation and must last for the delegations' entire stay.</p> <p>Delegation members with insufficient insurance coverage must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance coverage at the Federations own charge as follows: 10 USD per person/day.</p>
SAFEGUARDING	<p>From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable.</p> <p>The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site.</p> <p>In addition, posters of the "10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics", the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will have to be displayed in several locations, including training and warm-up halls and public zones.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the international travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by March 29, 2024.</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	Local transportation costs will be covered by the LOC. The LOC will take in charge transportation costs, for all accredited people, from the airport of Tashkent to official hotels and back, from official hotels to Gymnastics Sport Palace and back, only if hotel reservations are made through the LOC.

ACCREDITATION	<p>Accreditation of all delegations will take place upon arrival. The Heads of Delegations have to check the names of their own delegation members and hotel rooms reserved.</p> <p>The following are to be presented at the LOC Accreditation Office:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Passports of all members of the delegation - Valid FIG licences of gymnasts - National anthem in USB - National flag (120x 205 cm) - Gymnasts / Group music in USB – one USB for each routine - Insurance certificate for all delegation members covering illness (including COVID-19), accidents, repatriation. - Proof of full payment to LOC <p>In order to accelerate accreditation procedures, after the deadline of the definitive registration the LOC will send the link and pin-code to each participating Federation in order to upload the necessary information.</p> <p>If the photo must be taken at the Accreditation because none has been sent within the deadline or not sent in the official requested format, there will be a charge of 10 USD for each photo taken at the accreditation desk.</p> <p>In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.</p>
BANK ACCOUNT INFORMATION	<p>Bank details as well as the contract for payment will be sent to NFs by the LOC after receiving accommodation and meals forms from the participating Federations.</p> <p>The participating Federations are responsible for covering all bank fees in connection with the bank transfers.</p>
JUDGES AND JURIES	<p>All judges must have a valid FIG brevet for the respective discipline (RGI and/or RGG).</p> <p>The participating member federations must send minimum one qualified judge if they participate with individual gymnast(s) and one qualified judge if they participate with a group.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, or not sufficient cat. 1 and 2 judges, the Organizing Member Federation must propose to the AGU for prior approval of the Technical Delegate the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation.</p> <p>Such invitation must be made through the respective Member Federation. Should the Organizing Member Federation fail to propose names for additional judges, the AGU Office in consultation with the Technical Delegate concerned will invite these judges at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation.</p> <p>The selection of judges will be made:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - D Judges are drawn among the judges with cat. 1, 2 A and E Judges are drawn among the judges cat. 1, 2 and 3, T and L Judges may have a category 4, (for the draws, preference is given to the judges with the highest qualification). The Organizing Member Federation will apply a fine of USD 2000 per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC) should a federation fail to bring the required number of judges. This fine must be paid to the LOC by March 29, 2024. <p>The travel expenses and accommodation are to be borne by the participating Federations.</p>
