Team and All-Around Finals results will be determined by results of Qualifications.</p> <p>All the federations in good standing are entitled to participate either with a team of 3- 4 gymnasts (and 1 reserve) or with a maximum of 3 Individual gymnasts.</p> <p><u>Important:</u></p> <p>Member Federations with 3 individuals may be considered in the team ranking in the Qualifications and may be in the ranking list for the Team Final provided they register as a team at the provisional, definitive and nominative entry registration deadline.</p> <p>A Team shall be composed of a maximum of 4 gymnasts, 4 gymnasts may compete on any single piece of apparatus and the 3 highest scores will be taken into account for the team total.</p> <p>For men, the competition consists of optional exercises on six apparatus.</p>

	<p>To qualify for the vault finals, two vaults are necessary. The qualifying score is based on the average of the two scores. Only the first vault will count for the Team and All-Around ranking. <p>COMPETITION FORMAT SENIORS</p>	<p>OLYMPIC QUALIFICATION According to the FIG TR 2024, the 2024 Asian Championships is a qualifying event for the Summer Olympic Games in Paris 2024, see Appendix A to the TR, point D (Qualification Pathway - Criteria 7). The highest ranked eligible athlete based on the All-Around Final results from the Qualifications will obtain one quota place by name.</p> <p>FORMAT The competitions will be conducted according to FIG's Technical Regulations 2024 including Section 2 for Artistic Gymnastics, Reg. 5.1, with the following modifications. The competition consists of Qualifications, Team Final, All-Around Final and Apparatus Finals. Qualifications will also serve as the qualifications for the Apparatus Finals. All the federations in good standing are entitled to participate either with a team of 3- 5 gymnasts (and 1 reserve) or with a maximum of 3 Individual gymnasts.</p> <p>Important: Member Federations with 3 individuals may be considered in the team ranking in the Qualifications and may be in the ranking list for the Team Final provided they register as a team at the provisional, definitive, and nominative entry registration deadline. Apparatus Finals

The results of the finals determine the champion on each apparatus. The top eight gymnasts on each apparatus from the Apparatus Qualifications shall be qualified to participate in the Apparatus Finals (with maximum 2 gymnasts per Federation).

Award Ceremonies

Award ceremonies will be held after each competition. The gymnasts are required to attend the Awards ceremonies.

The medals will be granted to the top 3 gymnasts from each competition according to the result rankings.

In team Finals/ranking, each gymnast receives the awards, including the reserve gymnast. The same award will be presented to one designated coach at the same time.

INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the</p>	

	<p>members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. <p>JUDGES AND JURIES</p>	<p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet for their function with minimum Cat 3. As per FIG's General Judges Rules, Cat 4 Judge(s) may only serve as Time/Line Judge at the championships. The participating member federations must send two qualified judges for MAG if male gymnasts participate in the Team competition and one qualified MAG judge if male gymnasts participate in individual competitions only. The travel expenses and accommodation are to be borne by the participant Federations. The judges must bring the official uniform with them. The LOC will apply a fine of USD 1500 per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC) should a federation fail to bring the required number of judges. This fine must be paid to the LOC by 12 April 2024.</p>																
<p>PRIZE MONEY</p>	<p>AGU will pay the minimum prize money of USD 10,100 for the Men's Senior Asian Championships.
