<b>FEDERATIONS INVITED</b>	<p>The Organizing Member Federation will invite all AGU Member Federations in good standing.</p> <p>Federations which have not fulfilled their annual membership fees towards the AGU and the FIG and not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Organizing Committee will not be allowed to participate in the Asian Championships.</p>

<b>ENTRY FEES</b>	<p>Entry Fee</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 50 USD per Individual gymnasts</li> <li>• 100 USD per Group</li> </ul> <p>At the time of the Definitive Registration <b>15 Feb. 2024 100% of the Entry Fee must be paid</b> to the LOC.</p> <p>The entry fees should be paid by bank transfer onto the account of Uzbekistan Gymnastics Federation. Any bank charges will be shouldered by the delegation.</p>

	<p><b>Qualification for the Olympic Games Paris 2024:</b>  According to the FIG TR 2024, the 2024 Asian Championships is a qualifying event for the Summer Olympic Games in Paris 2024, see Appendix B to the TR, point D (Qualification Pathway - Criteria 3). The highest ranked Individual athlete based on AA Qualification Results (classification decided by the total number of points obtained on the 4 apparatus) will obtain one quota place by name. NOCs already qualified with 1 or 2 individuals cannot receive an additional quota place. The highest ranked Group based on AA Competition Results will obtain one quota place for its NOC. NOCs already qualified with a group cannot receive an additional quota place.</p>

<b>MEDICAL SERVICES</b>	The Organizing Committee will provide a first aid medical service, a doctor and emergency medical transportation in the competition area.																																							
<b>DOPING CONTROLS</b>	Doping controls will be organised by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of the FIG and according to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), the international standards enacted by the World Anti-doping Agency (WADA) and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.																																							
<b>COVID 19</b>	The LOC should follow local guidelines in management of COVID-19. The LOC must facilitate COVID-19 testing for delegations when it is required to have a negative test for return to their country.

The LOC will apply for the visa support letter to the Ministry of foreign affairs, after all arrangements LOC will send you the letter which should be printed and provided in the Uzbekistan Embassy in your country. If there is no the Uzbekistan Embassy or Consulate in your country you will get visa in Tashkent airport upon arrival, in this case please indicate this in the online visa application form.</p> <p>The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before 15 March, 2024 to the LOC.</p>
<b>INSURANCE</b>	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. Please also refer to <a href="https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medicalinsurance.php">https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medicalinsurance.php</a> for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance coverage at the Federations own charge as follows: 10 USD per person/day.</p>
<b>SAFEGUARDING</b>	<p>From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable.</p> <p>The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site.</p> <p>In addition, posters of the "10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics", the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will have to be displayed in several locations, including training and warm-up halls and public zones.</p>
<b>INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the international travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC <b>by March 29, 2024.</b></p>

<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	<p>Accreditation of all delegations will take place upon arrival.  The Heads of Delegations have to check the names of their own delegation members and hotel rooms reserved.  The following are to be presented at the LOC Accreditation Office:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Passports of all members of the delegation</li> <li>- Valid FIG licences of gymnasts</li> <li>- National anthem in USB</li> <li>- National flag (120x 205 cm)</li> <li>- Gymnasts / Group music in <b>USB – one USB for each routine</b></li> <li>- Insurance certificate for all delegation members covering illness (including COVID-19), accidents, repatriation.</li> <li>- Proof of full payment to LOC</li> </ul> <p>In order to accelerate accreditation procedures, after the deadline of the definitive registration the LOC will send the link and pin-code to each participating Federation in order to upload the necessary information.  If the photo must be taken at the Accreditation because none has been sent within the deadline or not sent in the official requested format, there will be a charge of 10 USD for each photo taken at the accreditation desk.  In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.</p>
<b>BANK ACCOUNT INFORMATION</b>	<p>Bank details as well as the contract for payment will be sent to NFs by the LOC after receiving accommodation and meals forms from the participating Federations.  The participating Federations are responsible for covering all bank fees in connection with the bank transfers.</p>
<b>JUDGES AND JURIES</b>	<p><b>All judges must have a valid FIG brevet for the respective discipline (RGI and/or RGG).</b></p> <p>The participating member federations must send minimum one qualified judge if they participate with individual gymnast(s) and one qualified judge if they participate with a group.  The Organizing Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, or not sufficient cat. 1 and 2 judges, the Organizing Member Federation must propose to the AGU for prior approval of the Technical Delegate the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation.  Such invitation must be made through the respective Member Federation.  Should the Organizing Member Federation fail to propose names for additional judges, the AGU Office in consultation with the Technical Delegate concerned will invite these judges at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation.  The selection of judges will be made:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- D Judges are drawn among the judges with cat. 1, 2</li> </ul> <p>A and E Judges are drawn among the judges cat. 1, 2 and 3, T and L Judges may have a category 4, (for the draws, preference is given to the judges with the highest qualification). The Organizing Member Federation will apply a fine of USD 2000 per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC) should a federation fail to bring therequired number of judges. This fine must be paid to the LOC by <b>March 29, 2024.</b>  <b>The travel expenses and accommodation are to be borne by the participating Federations.</b></p>

<b>PRIZE MONEY</b>	<p>AGU will pay the minimum prize money of USD 10,100 for the RG Senior Asian Championships.
