FEDERATIONS INVITED	The Pan American Gymnastics Union invites all Federations affiliated to the PAGU and the FIG and which are up to date in their obligations.

QUALIFICATION FOR OTHER EVENTS	This Championship will serve as qualifier event for the following competition: ▪ II Junior Pan American Games Asuncion 2025												
JUDGES AND JURIES	All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline. Each Federation must register 1 judge if participates with 1-2 gymnasts (individuals) and 2 judges if participates with 3-4 gymnasts (teams). The Federations can register a second judge (for individuals) or a third judge (for teams), different from the PAGU TC Member as additional accredited person, with no cost for this accreditation. Provision of max. 1 judge per NF per panel. The fine for not registering the required number of judges in each discipline is USD\$1,000.00 per missing judge. The Federations with a PAGU TC Member can register that Member in addition to their official judges. The fines for not registering the required number of judges must be paid to PAGU by March 25, 2024 at the latest and it does not apply to those Federations that do not have FIG brevet judges in the respective discipline (MAG, WAG) and that this is the first cycle in which they participate in PAGU competitions. The National Federation must inform PAGU at the time of the definitive registration (March 25, 2024) to allow the appointment of invited neutral judges.

ACCREDITATION	The cost of the accreditation for additional Delegation Members is USD\$100.00 per person and must be paid to the LOC by March 25, 2024 at the latest. Only the following persons can receive an additional accreditation: Coach (as per PAGU TR), Doctor, Physiotherapist, Team Manager. The accreditations of the second judge (individuals) or third judge (teams) different from PAGU TC Member have no cost.			
	Once the definitive registration period has ended (March 25, 2024) the COL will deliver to each registered Federation the user and the SportEvents password (https://sportevents.com.co). Along with the nominative registration all the Federations must upload to the PAGU intranet a copy of the passport and a photograph of each delegation member: upagu.vercel.app Additionally, the Federations must upload the information of their delegation (names, function, photos, etc.) to SportEvents. Requirements for the photos: • File format: JPEG • Dimensions: min 210 x 270 pixels; max 420 x 540 pixels • 3.5 cm width x 4.5 cm high • File size: no more than 1 MB • White background Each document must be identified with the Country Code, Last name, First Name, Competition (MAG, WAG) and function of each member. Example: PER_FERNANDEZ_Ana_WAG_gymnast This documentation must be uploaded on SportEvents and on the PAGU intranet no later than April 24, 2024. In case of not uploading the photograph as requested, the Local Organizing Committee can take the photograph during the registration and will have an additional cost of USD\$10.00 for each one. In case of theft or loss of accreditation, it must be informed immediately to the Local Organization Committee for the cancellation of the accreditation. The replacement of stolen or lost accreditation will cost USD\$50.00 to be covered by the accreditation holder. Accreditation will be distributed upon arrival at the registration desk. More information on the access zones for each accreditation will be given in the Work Plan. In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.

MEDICAL SERVICES	The Local Organizing Committee will provide first aid services and ambulance at the competition and training sites during the official activities.
ANTI-DOPING	<u>Doping controls</u> Doping controls will be organised by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of the FIG and according to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), the international standards enacted by the World Anti-doping Agency (WADA) and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.
COVID-19	The LOC should follow local guidelines in management of COVID-19. The LOC must facilitate COVID-19 testing for delegations when it is required to have a negative test for return to their country.
VISA	Please verify immediately with your travel agency or the Colombia Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Colombia. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before <u>April 24, 2024</u> to the LOC. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to. The request can be made at SportEvents after the definitive registration and no later than <u>April 24, 2024</u>.
INSURANCE	The host Federation, the LOC, the PAGU and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

	In order to benefit from the subsidiary insurance coverage of the FIG IMSSA, it is compulsory to have basic insurance in the country of residence (illness, accident and repatriation). Please also refer to https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges. The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance, no later than <u>April 24, 2024</u>. The LOC will offer insurance to the Federations, at their expense, at a cost of: <u>USD\$120.00</u> per person for all the official days of the event. If requested after this date (<u>April 24, 2024</u>), the total cost will be <u>USD\$150.00</u> per person for the official days of the event. The request can be made at SportEvents after the definitive registration on <u>March 25, 2024</u>.
SAFEGUARDING	From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable. The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site. In addition, posters of the “10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics”, the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will have to be displayed in several locations, including training and warm-up halls and public zones.
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The invited participating Federations must pay for the international travel costs of their delegation members. International Airport of arrival Simón Bolívar International Airport (SMR) Travel itinerary information must be provided to LOC via SportEvent no later than <u>April 24, 2024</u>.
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	Local transportation will be offered to and from the airport, provided that the delegations stay in one of the official hotels and book their accommodation through the Local Organizing Committee. The Local Organizing Committee will provide local transportation from the airport to the hotel and vice versa, only on the official arrival day of <u>Saturday, May 18</u>, and on the official departure day of <u>Sunday, May 26</u> (except for PAGU representatives arriving or departing on different days). The request for local transport on the official dates can be made at SportEvents after the definitive registration and no later than <u>April 24, 2024</u>. For delegations that arrive or return on non-official days, transportation to their accommodation (official hotels) or to the airport will cost <u>USD\$40.00</u> per person per trip (airport-hotel or hotel-airport). The request must be made at SportEvents and paid no later than <u>April 24, 2024</u>. The Local Organizing Committee will provide transportation from the official hotels to the competition facilities/training halls and vice versa, for all members of the delegation duly accredited and according to the official program of activities, provided that the delegation stays in one of the official hotels and books its accommodation through the Local Organizing Committee. Obs.: The two coliseums are 300 meters apart. We will provide transportation for the delegations that require it.

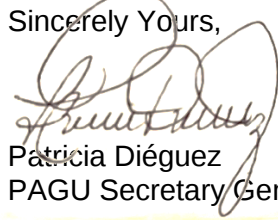

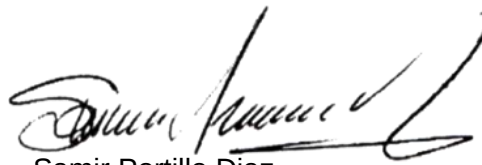
