**Games of the XXXIII Olympiad
Paris (FRA), 26 July – 11 August 2024**



ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS DRAWING OF LOTS PROCEDURES

Preamble

This draw will take place in two distinct phases:

- 1) The first phase will be conducted on 22 February 2024 at 10h00 CET and will include the first step of the draw for the Qualifications, to place Teams and Mixed Groups (MG) numbers into the Subdivisions and Apparatus. The provision of the Paris 2024 Qualification System, stipulating that NOCs will only have to confirm in writing to the FIG the use of their allocated Team place after the last qualification event for Paris 2024, remains valid.
- 2) The second phase will take place on 16 June 2024 at 10h00 CET. It will include the second step of the draw for the Qualifications, to place individual gymnasts into the MG numbers. It will also comprise the draw for the Apparatus Finals, to establish the working order on each apparatus.

Subject to the final list of qualified Teams and individual gymnasts, the FIG, in consultation with the MTC, the WTC and P2024, reserves the right to make adjustments to these procedures at any given time if required, or to modify the draw and starting order if organizational problems arise.

Qualifications

General principle:

- There are 3 Subdivisions for **MAG**, composed of :
 - 12 Team groups, with max. 1 Team per group.
 - 6 MG, with max. 6 individual gymnasts per group.Each subdivision must be composed of 4 Team groups and 2 MG.
- There are 5 Subdivisions for **WAG**, composed of :
 - 12 Team groups, with max. 1 Team per group.
 - 8 MG, with max. 4 groups with 5 individual gymnasts and max. 4 groups with 4 individual gymnasts.2 subdivisions must be composed of 3 Team groups and 1 MG.
3 subdivisions must be composed of 2 Team groups and 2 MG.
- Once the requested numbers of groups, gymnasts per group, and positions are distributed, the Subdivision, group, and position can no longer be considered.
- No individual gymnast may be added into a Team group.

First step (22 February 2024 at 10h00 CET)

To draw the Team groups and the MG numbers into the Subdivisions and Apparatus.

- To put the cards of countries with a Team and the cards with the MG numbers into bowl 1.
- To put the cards with the Subdivision numbers and Apparatus into bowl 2.
- To draw alternately from bowl 1 and bowl 2 until all countries with a Team and all MG numbers are distributed.

Second step (to be conducted at a location and time yet to be determined)

To draw the individual gymnasts into the MG numbers.

- To put the cards of countries with 3 individual gymnasts (if any) in bowl 1.
- To put the cards with the MG numbers in bowl 2.
- To draw alternately from bowl 1 and bowl 2, until all countries with 3 individual gymnasts (if any) are distributed.
- To put the cards of countries with 2 individual gymnasts (if any) in bowl 1.
- To draw alternately from bowl 1 and bowl 2, until all countries with 2 individual gymnasts (if any) are distributed.
- To put the cards of countries with 1 individual gymnast in bowl 1.
- To draw alternately from bowl 1 and bowl 2, until all countries with 1 individual gymnast are distributed.

Team Final

The teams ranked 1-8 after the Qualifications are seeded as identified in the Starting Order chart. The teams rotate from one apparatus to the other as per the Olympic apparatus order, as identified in the Working Order chart.

All-Around Final

The gymnasts ranked 1-24 after the Qualifications are seeded in Olympic apparatus order into one subdivision, as identified in the Starting Order chart. The individuals rotate from one apparatus to the other as per the Olympic apparatus order, as identified in the Working Order chart.

Apparatus Finals (to be conducted at a location and time yet to be determined)

In order to establish the working order on each apparatus, a draw is carried out, until the positions 1-8 are filled.

Podium Training and Training Groups

Podium Training and Training Groups follow the Qualifications' draw.
