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ENTRY FEES	The non-reimbursable cost for the Entry Fee (approved by the FIG) is of 50 USD per gymnast that should be paid by bank transfer.								
ACCREDITATION	<p>An accreditation system will be set up upon arrival of the delegations at. All officials and delegation members will need an accreditation to enter the training and competition halls.</p> <p>After Provisional Registration all NF receives the access to the LOC Platform. COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>The World Challenge Cup competitions consist of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Qualifications and Apparatus Finals • Gymnasts can only compete on the apparatus they register for • In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up in the Technical Regulations, Section 2 shall be applied. <p><u>Qualifications:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Participation is limited to 2 gymnasts per NF on each apparatus. ▪ In addition, the Organizing Member Federation is allowed to name a max. of 4 “hors concours” competitors (from the Organizing Member Federation) in Women’s Artistic Gymnastics and a max. of 4 “hors concours” competitors (from the Organizing Member Federation) in Men’s Artistic Gymnastics for a total of 8 “hors concours” gymnasts (i.e. while one “hors concours” gymnast can compete on more than one apparatus, not more than one “hors concours” gymnast can compete on an apparatus). DRAWING OF LOTS	<p>The gymnasts' drawing of lots for all FIG World Challenge Cup events will be managed electronically.</p> <p>If not possible, it will take place on site, during the orientation meeting or during a separate function organized for that purpose with invitation to all participating NFs. All delegations upon arrival/accreditation must submit a confirmation of starting order forms, a final validation of the delegation’s apparatus and starting order.</p> <p>The Technical Delegates may apply adjustments to the starting order should the Draw generate organizational problems at the time of the competition. ANTI-DOPING	<p><u>Doping controls</u> Doping controls will be organised by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of the FIG and according to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), the international standards enacted by the World Anti-doping Agency (WADA) and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.</p> <p><u>Host federation WADC compliance</u> The exploitation of any rights related to the hosting of an event is subject, at all times, to the compliance with the WADC and the international standards enacted by WADA. Regardless of whether the event has already been allocated or not, the FIG may terminate any collaboration with the host federation or the LOC, immediately and without paying any penalty and/or compensation or incurring liability of any kind, under the following circumstances: (i) if the National Anti-Doping Organisation (NADO) in charge in the concerned country is declared non-compliant by WADA (ii) if the relevant country has been ruled ineligible to host the event. In such cases, the FIG is entitled to reassign the event to any other host federation in another country where the WADC and the WADA international standards are fully respected.</p>
VISA	Please verify immediately via the link: https://mfa.uz/en/pages/visa-republic-uzb if a visa is required for your travel to Uzbekistan. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before May 1, 2025 to the LOC . The procedure of visa issuance is following: You need to fill in the online visa application form on the web site: http://evisa.mfa.uz/evisa_en/ , save and send it to us along with the passport copy. The LOC will apply for the visa support letter to the Ministry of foreign affairs, after all arrangements LOC will send you the letter which should be printed and provided in the Uzbekistan Embassy in your country. If there is no the Uzbekistan Embassy or Consulate in your country you will get visa in Tashkent airport upon arrival, in this case please indicate this in the online visa application form.
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. WAG FX MUSIC	An online system, proposed by the FIG, will be used to download the floor music of all gymnasts, to provide information on the musical data and to help the NFs ensure that all music is correctly authorized for use in competition.

	<p>The number of judges' panels will be decided by the organizing member federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges.</p> <p>The judges' panels are set up by a draw from the judges present at the Judges meeting. The draw must be directed by the MAG and WAG Technical Delegates. The participating member federations must send minimum one qualified judge for MAG if they participate with male gymnasts and one qualified WAG judge if they participate with female gymnasts.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation will apply a fine of CHF 2'000 per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC) should a federation fail to bring the required number of judges. This fine must be paid to the LOC by May 1, 2025.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, the Organizing Member Federation must propose to the FIG for approval the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves, 1 for MAG and 1 for WAG). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation. Such invitation must be made through the respective Member Federation. Should the Organizing Member Federation fail to propose names for additional judges, the FIG Office in consultation with the TC Presidents concerned will invite these judges at the cost (in terms of international and local travel, accommodation and meals) of the Organizing Member Federation. For additional judge's requirements see the Specific Judges' Rules.</p>																		
<p>SCORING AND RESULT SERVICE</p>	<p>Sportsaround will be the official Scoring and Result Service System for this FIG World Challenge Cup. This System will provide appropriate outputs, including a high-quality video control system (FIG TR).</p>																		
<p>VIDEO CONTROL SYSTEM</p>	<p>Should IRCOS not be available, the Organising Member Federation must provide another video control system (as per the Technical Regulations, Section 1, Art. 4.10.4.1) which allows to treat inquiries and records all exercises of the competition in a quality which allows to judge the exercises. The videos must be sent to the FIG office within one week after the competition.</p>

In case of a tie at any rank, the prize money of the equal ranks is added and divided by the number of ties.

The LOC will not be responsible for any local taxes payable in the beneficiary's residence country

ASSIGNMENT OF POINTS FOR THE WORLD CHALLENGE CUP SERIES

At the end of each competition, World Challenge Cup points are assigned on each apparatus by considering first the competitors ranked in the Apparatus Finals and then, the competitors ranked in the Qualifications, as follow:

In case a gymnast received a DNS/DNF during the Apparatus Finals, points will be awarded based on the Qualifications ranks. If after application of the tie breaking rules outlined in the Technical Regulations, Section 2, there is still a tie, the points of the equal ranks will be added and divided by the number of ties.

In case that less than four federations participating per apparatus, no World Challenge Cup points will be given.

Based on the World Challenge Cup points assigned, separate men's and women's World Challenge Cup Ranking Lists are established on each apparatus as follow:

WINNER OF THE ANNUAL WORLD CHALLENGE CUP SERIES	<p>The winner of the annual World Challenge Cup Series is the gymnast with the highest number of points on the respective apparatus after the last event of the year, taking into consideration the best results (maximum 3), regardless of the number of competitions the athletes participated in.</p> <p>Should there be a tie after the last competition, it will be broken as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The ranks of the max. three (3) counting exercises will be added and the gymnast with the lowest total prevails. Note: in case of a tie in the ranks to determine the three counting exercises, the exercises with the highest final scores will prevail. If the tie remains, the final scores of the max. three (3) counting exercises will be averaged and the gymnast with the highest average prevails. If the tie remains, the total E-scores of the max. three (3) counting exercises (max. six (6) scores for Vault) will be averaged and the gymnast with the highest average prevails. If the tie remains, the total D-scores of the max. three (3) counting exercises (max. six (6) scores for Vault) will be averaged and the gymnast with the highest average prevails. <p>A special award ceremony must be held at the last World Challenge Cup Competition of the year in which the World Challenge Cup series winners shall receive a Cup.</p>
