FIG AND CONSUGI LICENCES	<p>CONSUGI LICENSE: For the year 2024, the license fee is \$15 USD for those who did not pay in 2023. This license is valid until September 31, 2024. ALL ATHLETES MUST OBTAIN IT.</p> <p>The proforma invoice for CONSUGI licenses will be available for download during the Nominative Registration at www.creatuevento.com. 	<p>be paid in cash during the accreditation process.</p> <p>FIG LICENSE: All gymnasts in the SENIOR and JUNIOR categories, in addition to presenting their CONSUGI license, must also present a valid FIG license.</p> <p>All delegations are requested to check the validity of their licenses on the official pages: https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/athletes/lic_view.php</p>
JUDGES AND PANEL	<p>All judges must hold a valid FIG brevet as of the date of the event and in the respective discipline.</p> <p>JUDGES FOR SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS *1 If a country participates in the Senior or Junior event, it must register at least 1 FIG international brevet Level 4 (Cycle 2022-2024) or higher judge for each discipline in which it registers. Otherwise, it will incur a penalty of USD \$1,200 for each missing judge. Countries competing for the first time in the South American Senior or Junior event are exempt. The National Federation must inform CONSUGI in advance (at least at the time of nominative registration) to allow for the appointment of an invited judge. The penalty payment MUST be made in cash at the time of accreditation. NOTE: Participating federations are responsible for covering all bank transfer fees.</p>

REGISTRATION PAYMENTS	<p>Registrations will be valid only if submitted through federations affiliated with CONSUGI and the FIG. Late registrations will not be accepted, and participation will not be permitted.</p> <p>Participants must have reached the required age by December 31 of the year of the competition. CONSUGI reserves the right to verify the passports of all gymnasts. A fee of \$30 USD per athlete for registration (this amount was approved at the CONSUGI assembly in November 2017).</p> <p>To download the proforma invoice for registrations, you must first complete the Nominative Registration on the platform provided: http://creatuevento.com/. ACCREDITATIONS	<p>Accreditations will be handed out to the Head of Delegation at the Delegates' Meeting. Access to buses, training rooms, and competition areas will not be</p>

	<p>allowed for those who do not possess and show their accreditation, which is personal and non-transferable and must be worn at all times, remaining visible (except for athletes during training and competitions). If your accreditation credential is lost, please contact the person responsible for your delegation immediately.</p> <p>The cost for additional accreditations (coaches, team leaders, doctors, physiotherapists, chaperones) will be USD \$100.00 each. This accreditation grants access to designated areas according to the role, internal transportation, and farewell banquet (if applicable).</p> <p>In case of theft or loss of the accreditation, you must inform the COL immediately to block the accreditation. Stolen or lost accreditations can be replaced for a fee of USD \$20.00, which will be the responsibility of the credential holder.</p> <p>In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.</p>

INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	Invited Federations must cover the costs of international transportation to the host city for their delegation members. LOCAL TRANSPORT	Local transportation to and from the airport will be provided as long as the delegations stay at one of the official hotels and book their accommodation through the Local Organizing Committee (LOC). The LOC will provide local transportation from the airport to the hotel and vice versa only. The LOC will provide transportation from the official hotels to the competition and training venues and back for all duly accredited delegation members who have booked their accommodation through the LOC and according to the official activity schedule.

This email will include a request for payment of 50% of the total value based on the first hotel option selected. The hotel reservation will be made once the deposit is received. Invited participating federations must cover accommodation costs for their delegation members. Accommodation and meal costs must be paid to the LOC via bank deposit. Failure to make payment by the required dates will result in cancellation of the reservation and forfeiture of the deposit. All personal expenses (e.g., additional hotel services, laundry, room service, phone calls, minibar, etc.) are not included. Any charges incurred for these services must be settled directly with the hotel before departure. All outstanding accounts will be the responsibility of each participating Federation.
