

ACCREDITATION	<p>Accreditation cards will be distributed at the Accreditation Centre situated at the Competition Venue upon arrival of the delegations. The following items will be checked there with the Heads of delegations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The passport of gymnasts and all members of the delegations• Fulfilment of all financial obligations• Transport – Departure• The medical insurance for the members of the delegations• 2 sets of Audio CD’s/USB of the music• National anthem and national flag <p>In order to accelerate the process of the accreditation, each participating Federation is kindly requested to upload photos and passport copy of each member of its delegation (gymnasts, head of delegation, team manager, judges, coaches, medical staff and etc.) onto the SmartScoring Digital Platform (https://gymdata.online/).</p> <p>The deadline for the photos upload (identity colour photo in JPG format, size – 45mm x 35mm, resolution: 800x600plx) is 24 February 2025. Please clearly indicate the corresponding full name (with correct spelling) in the file title.</p>					

EVENT FORMAT	<p>Uploading of photos in due time will prevent the delegations from waiting at the accreditation centre.</p> <p>In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding gymnasts' safeguarding plan.</p> <p>Junior Individuals Qualifying competition with Team ranking - each gymnast must perform at least one (1) routine - each NF has the right to choose the number of routines to be performed per its gymnast - each NF has the right to choose the apparatus to be performed per its gymnast - the minimum number of routines per gymnast is 1, the maximum is 4 routines - the maximum number of routines per NF is 4 in total, i.e. one (1) per apparatus -The results of the 4 exercises will be added. The team with the highest score in total of 4 exercises will be awarded with the winner title. NF with only 1 gymnast cannot participate in the Team ranking. The participating federations can have more than one team in the competition, but only one team with the highest result will be taken into account while defining the prize-winners.</p> <p>Apparatus Finals The best eight (8) gymnasts of the Qualifications on each of the 4 apparatus of the programme will participate in the Individual Apparatus Finals, no matter if they participate with or without a Team. Only one gymnast per country can participate in the Apparatus Finals. Azerbaijan, as a host country, can participate with 2 gymnasts in the Apparatus Finals.</p> <p>Junior Groups (5 Hoops and/or 5 Clubs) Qualifying competition with All-Around ranking -Group competition (5-6 gymnasts) with 1 or 2 exercises. Reserve gymnast should perform at least one routine. -The results of the 2 exercises will be added. The group with the highest result after the 2 exercises, is awarded with the winner title. The participating federations can have more than one group in the competition, but only one group with the highest result will be taken into account while defining the prize-winners in the All-Around. If NF`s group executes only one exercise, she can take part in the Apparatus Final.</p> <p>Apparatus Finals The best 8 Groups are qualified for the Apparatus Finals. NF may participate with only 1 exercise in each final.</p> <p>Senior Individuals (Hoop – Ball – Clubs – Ribbon) Qualifying competition with Team (2-3 gymnasts per team) and All-Around ranking The gymnasts present maximum 8 exercises (2 hoops, 2 balls, 2 clubs, 2 ribbons). A gymnast may participate in 1 – 4 exercises. If a NF participates with only 1 gymnast, she must present 4 exercises. NF with only 1 gymnast can participate in the qualifying competition and All-Around ranking but not in the Team ranking. The result of 3 best scored exercises will be added to All-Around ranking. In the All-Around ranking 1 gymnast per country can be awarded according to the result of qualifying competition. The participating federations can have more than one team in the competition, but only one team with the highest result will be taken into account while defining the prize-winners.</p> <p>Apparatus Finals The best eight (8) gymnasts of the Qualifications on each of the 4 apparatus of the programme will participate in the Individual Apparatus Finals, no matter if they participate with or without a Team. Only one gymnast per country can participate in the Apparatus Finals. Azerbaijan, as a host country, can participate with 2 gymnasts in the Apparatus Finals.</p>

	<p>Senior Groups (5 Ribbons, 3 Balls & 2 Hoops) Group competition (5-6 gymnasts) with 2 different exercises, one executed with 1 apparatus, the other with 2 types of apparatus, according to the FIG program for the respective year. Reserve gymnast perform at least one routine. The group with the highest score in the All-Around competition is awarded with the winner title. The All-Around competition is also a qualifying competition for the Apparatus final. The participating federations can have more than one team in the competition, but only one team with the highest result will be taken into account while defining the prize-winners in the All-Around.</p> <p>Apparatus Finals The best 8 Groups are qualified for the Apparatus Finals. NF may participate with only 1 exercise in each final. Azerbaijan, as a host country, can participate with 2 groups in the Apparatus Finals.</p>

INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation and LOC will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. It is just opposite the MGA.</p> <p>The costs per room at Sport Plaza hotel are as follows: 75 EUR – (single room, including breakfast) 100 EUR – (twin room with shared bathroom, including breakfast) 110 EUR – (twin room with separate bathroom, including breakfast)</p> <p><u>Distances</u> Airport – 17,5 km (18 min. drive) Training/competition venue – 4,7 km (6 min. drive)</p> <p>The prices charged for the hotel rooms cannot exceed the usual hotel rates.</p> <p>While the Accommodation Form must be returned to the LOC via SmartScoring Digital Platform (https://gymdata.online/) by 07 February 2025 at the very latest, the Hotel rooms will be allocated on a “first come, first served” basis.
