ACCREDITATION	<p>Accreditation cards will be distributed at the Accreditation Centre situated at the LOC office upon arrival of the delegations. The following items will be checked there with the Heads of delegations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The passport of gymnasts and all members of the delegations • Fulfilment of all financial obligations • Transport – Departure • The medical insurance for the members of the delegations • 2 sets of Audio CD's/USB of the music • National anthem and national flag <p>In order to accelerate the process of the accreditation, each participating Federation is kindly requested to upload photos and passport copy of each</p>				



The access to the platform will be sent after Definitive Registration.</p> <p>In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding gymnasts' safeguarding plan.</p>										
EVENT FORMAT	<p><u>Junior Individuals</u> <i>Qualifying competition with Team ranking</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - each gymnast must perform at least one (1) routine - each NF has the right to choose the number of routines to be performed per its gymnast - each NF has the right to choose the apparatus to be performed per its gymnast - the minimum number of routines per gymnast is 1, the maximum is 4 routines - the maximum number of routines per NF is 4 in total, i.e. one (1) per apparatus <p>The results of the 4 exercises will be added. The team with the highest score in total of 4 exercises plus 2 group exercises will be awarded with the winner title.</p> <p><i>NF with only 1 gymnast cannot participate in the Team ranking</i></p> <p>The participating federations can have more than one team in the competition, but only one team with the highest result will be taken into account while defining the prize winners.</p> <p><u>Apparatus Finals</u> The best eight (8) gymnasts of the Qualifications on each of the 4 apparatus of the programme will participate in the Individual Apparatus Finals, no matter if they participate with or without a Team. Only one gymnast per country can participate in the Apparatus Finals. Uzbekistan, as a host country, can participate with 2 gymnasts in the Apparatus Finals.</p> <p><u>Junior Groups (5 Hoops and/or 5 Pairs of Clubs)</u> <i>Qualifying competition with All-Around ranking</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Group competition (5-6 gymnasts) with 1 or 2 exercises. Reserve gymnast should perform at least one routine. -The results of the 2 exercises will be added. The group with the highest result after the 2 exercises, is awarded with the winner title. <p>The participating federations can have more than one group in the competition, but only one group with the highest result will be taken into account while defining the prize winners in the All-Around.</p> <p>If NF's group executes only one exercise, it can take part in the Apparatus Final.</p> <p><u>Apparatus Finals</u> The best 8 Groups are qualified for the Apparatus Finals. NF may participate with only 1 exercise in each final.</p>

MEDICAL SERVICES	The Organizing Committee will provide first aid medical services. Physiotherapists will be present during the competitions.
VISA	Please verify immediately via the link: https://mfa.uz/en/pages/visa-republic-uzb if a visa is required for your travel to Uzbekistan. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before 5 March 2025 to the LOC. The procedure of visa issuance is following: You need to fill in the online visa application form on the web site: http://evisa.mfa.uz/evisa_en/ , save and send it to us along with the passport copy. The LOC will apply for the visa support letter to the Ministry of foreign affairs, after all arrangements LOC will send you the letter which should be printed and provided in the Uzbekistan Embassy in your country. If there is no the Uzbekistan Embassy or Consulate in your country you will get visa in Tashkent airport upon arrival, in this case please indicate this in the online visa application form.
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. Please also refer to https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges. The LOC will verify the insurance coverage upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). The insurance must be valid at least starting from the arrival day of the delegation and must last for the delegations' entire stay</p> <p>The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: 10 USD per person/day.</p>
SAFEGUARDING	<p>From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable.</p> <p>The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site.</p> <p>In addition, posters of the "10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics", the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will have to be displayed in several locations, including training and warm-up halls and public zones.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the international travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by April 4, 2025.</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	Local transportation costs will be covered by the LOC. The LOC will take in charge transportation costs, for all accredited people, from the airport of Tashkent to official hotels and back, from official hotels to Gymnastics Sport Palace and back, only if hotel reservations are made through the LOC.
ACCOMMODATION	<p>The hotel prices are per room per night, include breakfast and city taxes are as follows:</p> <p>Category 1 Hotel **** 230 USD (single room, breakfast included) 280 USD (double room, breakfast included)</p> <p>Category 2 Hotel *** 150 USD (single room, breakfast included) 180 USD (double room, breakfast included)</p>

	<p>The “low cost” Hotel: 120 USD (double room, breakfast included) 150 USD (triple room, breakfast included) There are no any single rooms in “low cost” hotel.</p> <p>The Accommodation Form must be returned to the LOC by 5 March 2025 at the very latest, the Hotel rooms will be allocated on a “first come, first serve” basis.</p> <p>Fine for the late accommodation form delivery (after 5 March 2025): \$200.00 to be paid for the LOC. After the 5 April 2025 an accommodation change request has to be submitted to the LOC in written form. A fee \$20.00 then will be charged per change request. Fees for changes request are in addition of cancellation form.</p> <p>After receiving your Accommodation form the LOC will contact you.</p>
