AGE LIMITS	Junior & Senior, as per FIG Technical Regulations. All gymnasts must have an FIG licence valid until the end of the event.						
JUDGES	All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet (min IV) at the time of the event, in the respective category (RGI and/or RGG). If a Federation does not enter a judge or comes with a judge of an insufficient level, LOC will request the payment of a fine of 150 EUR per missing judge.

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ENTRY FEES	<p>The non-refundable entry fee for this event will be as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50 EUR per RGI gymnast • 150 EUR per Group • 100 EUR per person (incl. gymnasts, coaches and staff), who have not booked their accommodation through LOC. 						
ACCREDITATION	<p>The accreditation procedure will take place at the competition hall.</p> <p>Heads of delegation must bring to the accreditation office:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passports or copies (on paper) of all participants • Certification of insurance for all delegation members covering illness, accidents and repatriation (on paper) <p>In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.</p>						
COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>Junior RGI (FIG Rules) ALL-AROUND TEAM COMPETITION AND QUALIFICATION FOR FINALS:</p> <p>The Federations participating with 2-4 gymnasts will join the Team Competition. They must present 4 exercises according to the junior program. In a team competition, a gymnast may participate with 1-3 exercises. No more than 4 exercises can be executed per Federation (except host NF). The team result will be calculated based on all 4 presented exercises. If a NF participates with only 1 gymnast, she must present an exercise with each of the 4 apparatus and can qualify with each apparatus for the Apparatus Finals. However, she won't be ranked in the team ranking and won't get a medal/certificate for AA.</p> <p>APPARATUS FINAL: The best 8 gymnasts per apparatus – max 1 per Federation (except host NF)</p> <p>Senior RGI (FIG Rules) ALL-AROUND AND QUALIFICATION FOR FINALS:</p> <p>Each gymnast performs 4 exercises</p> <p>Each Federation can participate with max. 2 gymnasts.</p> <p>APPARATUS FINAL: The best 8 gymnasts per apparatus – max 1 per Federation (except host NF)</p> <p>Senior RGG (FIG Rules) ALL-AROUND AND QUALIFICATION FOR FINALS:</p> <p>Each Group performs 2 exercises.</p> <p>APPARATUS FINAL: The best 8 Groups per apparatus – max 1 per Federation</p>

VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent, the German Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Fellbach-Schmiden (Germany). The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation Member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before 01.02.2025 to the LOC.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). The insurance must be valid at least starting from the arrival day of the delegation and must last for the delegations' entire stay. Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.</p>
SAFEGUARDING	<p>From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable.</p> <p>The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site.</p> <p>In addition, posters of the "10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics", the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will have to be displayed in several locations, including training and warm-up halls and public zones.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members to and from Stuttgart airport or Stuttgart main train station.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 01.02.2025</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The LOC will arrange the local transportation from Stuttgart Airport or Stuttgart main train station for all participating NFs, who have booked their accommodation through LOC.</p> <p>The local transport is ensured from the official day of arrival to the official day of departure.</p>
ACCOMMODATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the accommodation expenses of their delegation members.</p> <p>The costs per person and per night are as follows:</p> <p>EUR 155,00 (single room) EUR 125,00 (double room) EUR 110,00 (triple room – first come, first serve)</p>
