<b>FEDERATIONS INVITED</b>	The Pan American Gymnastics Union invites all Federations affiliated to the PAGU and the FIG and which are up to date in their obligations.																
<b>AGE LIMITS</b>	<b>Junior</b> , as per FIG Technical regulations <b>All gymnasts must have a valid FIG license until the end of the event.</b>																
<b>JUDGES AND JURIES</b>	<p><b>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline.</b></p> <p>Each Federation may register a maximum of 2 judges on each competition where is registered (TRA, DMT). The fine for not registering at least one judge in the respective competition is <b>USD\$1,000.00</b>. Federations with a PAGU TC Member can register that Member in addition to their official judges. The fines for not registering the required number of judges must be paid to PAGU by <b>March 17, 2025</b> at the latest and it does not apply to those Federations that do not have FIG brevet judges in the respective competition (TRA, DMT) and that this is the first cycle in which they participate in PAGU competitions. The National Federation must inform PAGU at the time of the definitive registration (<b>March 17, 2025</b>) to allow the appointment of invited neutral judges.</p>

In case of not sending the photograph as requested, the Local Organizing Committee can take the photograph during the registration and will have an additional cost of <b>USD\$20.00</b> for each one.  In case of theft or loss of accreditation, it must be informed immediately to the Local Organization Committee for the cancellation of the accreditation.  The replacement of stolen or lost accreditation will cost <b>USD\$35.00</b> to be covered by the accreditation holder.  Accreditation will be distributed upon arrival at the registration desk. <b>MEDICAL SERVICES</b>	The Local Organizing Committee will provide first aid services and ambulance at the competition and training sites during the official activities.
<b>ANTI-DOPING</b>	<p><b><u>Doping controls</u></b></p> <p>Doping controls will be organized by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of the FIG and according to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), the international standards enacted by the World Anti-doping Agency (WADA) and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.</p>
<b>VISA</b>	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Salvadoran Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to El Salvador. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before <b><u>April 16, 2025</u></b> to the LOC. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>
<b>INSURANCE</b>	<p>The host Federation, the LOC, the PAGU and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance.</p> <p>Please also refer to <a href="https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php">https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php</a> for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: <b>USD\$55.00</b> per person per day for the official days of the event.</p>
<b>SAFEGUARDING</b>	<p>From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable.</p> <p>The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site.</p> <p><b>In addition, posters of the “10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics”, the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will have to be displayed in several locations, including training and warm-up halls and public zones.</b></p>

<p><b>LOCAL TRANSPORTATION</b></p>	<p>Local transportation will be offered to and from the airport, provided that the delegations stay in one of the official hotels and book their accommodation through the Local Organizing Committee. The Local Organizing Committee will provide local transportation from the airport to the hotel and vice versa, only on the official arrival day of <u>Tuesday May 13</u>, and on the official departure day of <u>Monday May 19</u> (except for PAGU representatives arriving or departing on different days).
