<p>2025 OCEANIA RHYTHMIC GYMNASTICS CONTINENTAL CHAMPIONSHIPS</p>	<p>Oceania Federations will compete at the Asian Rhythmic Gymnastics Championships for 2025. This event will serve as the Oceania Continental Championships.</p> <p>The maximum delegation size of individual gymnasts is three (+1 reserve). For the RGI Team Competition, Federations can enter up to 3 Senior International Individual athletes. Up to 3 athletes can compete on any apparatus, with the top 2 scores per apparatus (8 scores total) to contribute to the RGI Team score.</p> <p>Awards</p> <p>OGU medals will be awarded to the Top 3 Federations from the RGI Team competition. Medals will be awarded to the athletes (not including the reserve athlete) & the Federation's Team Coach only.</p> <p>World Championships Quota Places for Individuals</p> <p>The RGI Team results will be based on the Qualification Round (16th & 17th May) of the competition. The ranking and results will be separate from Asian Rhythmic Gymnastics Championships.</p> <p>The Oceania Continental Individual Quota place (2-3 gymnasts) will be allocated to the Federation with the highest RGI Team All-Around score. The Oceania Continental Individual Quota place (1 individual) will be allocated to the Federation who did not qualify the Quota place for 2-3 Individual gymnasts.</p>

	DOPING CONTROL	Doping controls will be organised by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of the FIG and according to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), the international standards enacted by the World Anti-doping Agency (WADA) and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.

	<p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. 

JUDGES AND JURIES	<p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet for their function with minimum Cat 3. As per FIG's General Judges Rules, Cat 4 Judge(s) may only serve as Time/Line Judge at the championships.</p> <p>The participating member federations must send a minimum of one qualified judge if they participate with individual gymnast(s) and one qualified judge if they participate with a group.</p> <p>The Organising Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, or not sufficient cat. 1 and 2 judges, the Organising Member Federation must propose to the AGU for prior approval of the Technical Delegate the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves).
