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## **5. WELCOME – OFFICIAL LANGUAGE**

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- The delegations will be welcomed on behalf of the Organizing Committee upon arrival in Riccione at the accreditation desk at the Competition Hall. In case of late arrival delegations will be accompanied directly to the hotel and the accreditation procedure will be carried out the morning after.
- The official language of this world cup is English. Announcements will be made in Italian and English only. The Work Plan and all other documents are available in English only.

## **6. ACCREDITATION**

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- Accreditation will take place at the accreditation desk upon arrival. Accreditation desk will be available on April 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> from 8.00 to 18.00.
- At the moment of accreditation Heads of Delegation are required to verify the names of their entire delegation and the accommodation requirements. They have to pay any outstanding amounts due to the OC and / or the FIG, provide their confirmation of insurance and check their national anthem and national flag. They are also asked to provide bank details to be used to pay the money prize for the awarded gymnasts.
- HOD are requested to provide a valid phone number (working in Italy) and e-mail address. These contact details will be used during and after the competition to inform delegations about possible risky contacts.
- As far as the number of accreditations per country is concerned, the FIG Rules and the Directives will be strictly applied.
- All delegation members will receive an accreditation ID Card. The accreditation ID Card is personal, non-transferable and compulsory to get access to the training and competition hall, functions, and the bus system. All participants and officials are required to wear the ID Cards at all times.

## **7. NATIONAL FLAG AND ANTHEM**

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Delegations will be requested to check their national anthem and their national flag upon accreditation.

## **8. HOTELS / MEALS – INFORMATION**

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- All delegations will receive the hotel details before arrival by email.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served in the respective hotels. Breakfast 7.00 – 9.30; Lunch 11.30 – 14.30; Dinner 19.00 – 21.30.
- Lunch for those judges involved in competition at lunch time will be served at the Venue.
- Please note that the Organizing Committee is not liable for any damages in the hotel rooms, costs for mini-bars, pay-TV or the like. This is the responsibility of each delegation.
- Please note that the latest check-out time is 10.00h at the day of departure.

## **9. LOCAL TRANSPORTATION**

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- The Organizing Committee will provide shuttle bus transportation between airports, railways station, hotels and competition venue between April 3<sup>rd</sup> and April 7<sup>th</sup> for arrival/departure, training and competition. Transport will be arranged as a circular line serving all hotels and the venue. A detailed schedule will be handed in to delegation upon arrival and will be available at hotels and the Competition Hall. The transport is to the sole use of the delegations, which has booked their accommodation through the OC.

## 11. ORIENTATION MEETING

- The Orientation Meeting will take place on Thursday April, 3rd at 18.00h at Hotel Cristallo, Via Dante 34 – Riccione
- The orientation meeting is **compulsory for all Heads of Delegation**.
- At this meeting all information concerning the detailed organization of the World Cup will be given by the Organizing Committee and the FIG. **The meeting will be held in English only**.

## 12. VENUE ACCESS

- Delegation arriving for ACCREDITATION must enter the Venue from the main entrance.
- Delegation arriving for TRAINING AND COMPETITION must enter from the back side of the Venue.
- Judges arriving to ACT IN A PANEL must enter from the back side of the Venue.
- Spectators must enter from the main entrance of the Venue.

### **13. DRAWING OF LOTS**

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- The draw for the starting order for the Qualification Round was done beforehand at the FIG headquarters.
- The final starting order will be established and distributed by email to the delegations directly following the Orientation Meeting.

### **14. EQUIPMENT**

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- See detailed equipment list published on FIG website.

Only one DMT will be available in the Competition Area. All DMT trainings will be in competition area.

### **15. MUSIC**

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- The organizing committee would like to point out that **during the competition**, background music will be played at a low volume. Please let your gymnasts know this in advance.

### **16. JUDGES INSTRUCTION AND MEETING**

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- The judges' instruction, which is **compulsory for all judges**, will take place online on Friday April, 4<sup>th</sup> at 11.00 at Hotel Cristallo, Via Dante 34 – Riccione.
- Please note that the judges' instruction will be held in English only. Judges who don't participate in the judges' instruction may not be authorized to judge and their respective federations may face a penalty fee of up to 2.000 CHF.
- During the meeting judges will be requested to provide a valid phone number (working in Italy) to receive any relevant information during the competition.

### **17. DRAWING OF LOTS FOR JUDGES**

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- The judges will be drawn after the judges' instruction on Friday April, 4<sup>th</sup> from those that were put forward by the federations. Judges must be duly licensed (valid FIG license with the appropriate requested category).

### **18. COMPETITION CARDS**

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- Competition cards must be returned to the competition secretariat at the Accreditation Office within Friday April, 4<sup>th</sup> at 12.00.

### **19. PUBLICATION OF THE SCORES**

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- A detailed list of results, including judges' marks, will be sent to National federations and to the Heads of Delegation after the finals. During the competition, all results will be published in the venue and published on the following web-site [www.gymresult.it](http://www.gymresult.it)

### **20. NO SMOKING POLICY**

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- Please note that it is strictly forbidden to smoke in the venue complex (including toilets and changing rooms) and hotels.

## 21. MEDICAL SERVICES

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- On April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> the Organizing Committee will provide medical services and an ambulance will be at the Competition Hall.

## 22. DOPING CONTROL

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- Doping controls may be made during the World Cup – as per the FIG, IOC and WADA regulations
  - by the Italian Gymnastics Federation. The doping controls can take place during training and / or competition.

## 23. SAFEGUARDING

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- As per FIG – Framework for Safeguarding during Events a Safeguarding Officer will be operating during the event.  
Details and contact will be shared during the Orientation Meeting and available in the Venue.

## 24. MARCH IN

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- The competitors are asked to assemble in the assembly area 5 minutes prior to each competition.  
The athletes are asked to wear the competition attire.

## 25. WARM UP

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- Immediately prior to the **Qualifying Round** and **Finals** each competitor/pair will be allowed **45 seconds** of warm-up on the competition apparatus.
- Two or one pass for DMT.

A separate gym for warm up on floor and stretching will be available as per the following schedule:

- Tuesday, April 1<sup>st</sup> from 8.00 to 16.00
- Wednesday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> from 8.00 to 16.00
- Thursday, April 3<sup>rd</sup> from 8.00 to 16.00
- Friday, April 4<sup>th</sup> from 8.00 to 16.00
- Saturday, April 5<sup>th</sup> from 8.00 to 19.00
- Sunday, April 6<sup>th</sup> from 8.00 to 18.00

- Only the medal winners are invited to participate. They must wear according to FIG rules.
- Gymnasts are asked to be ready in the warm up area 10 minutes before the awarding ceremony start time. That means that everyone but for the Mixed Pair finalists, who will join the group right after the end of their competition, has to be ready in competition attire in the warm up area as soon as they finish the competition.
