<b>FEDERATIONS INVITED</b>	<p>The Organizing Member Federation will invite all AGU Member Federations in good standing. Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the FIG (e.g. annual membership fees, unpaid invoices, etc.) AGU or the LOC may not be allowed to participate in these Asian Art. Gymnastics Championships.</p>				
<b>AGE LIMITS</b>	<p>Age limit for WAG Juniors: as per FIG technical regulations Age limit for WAG Seniors: as per FIG technical regulations</p>				
<b>FIG LICENSE</b>	<b>All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.</b>				
<b>JUDGES AND JURIES</b>	<p><b>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet, with minimum Cat 2 for D-Judges and minimum Cat 3 for E-Judges.</b> As per FIG General Judges' Rules, Cat 4 Judge(s) may only serve as Time/Line Judge at the championships. The participating member federations must send two qualified judges for WAG if female gymnasts participate in the Team competition and one qualified WAG judge if participates in the Individual competition only. The travel expenses and accommodation are to be borne by the participant Federations. The judges must bring the official uniform with them. The LOC will apply a fine of USD 1500 per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC) should a federation fail to bring the required number of judges. This fine must be paid to the LOC by 12 May 2025.</p>

<b>ENTRY FEES</b>	<p>Entry Fee is 50 USD per gymnast. At the time of the Definitive registration <b>12 April, 2025</b> 100% of the Entry Fee must be paid to the LOC. The entry fees should be paid by bank transfer onto account of Jecheon Gymnastics Association. Any bank charges will be shouldered by the delegation.</p>				
<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	<p>To arrange the accreditation procedures for all participating delegation members, electronic ID photographs must be sent to the LOC within the deadline set for the nominative registration.</p> <p>Heads of Delegations have to check information about their own delegation as regards of hotel reservations and payments. <b>COMPETITION FORMAT JUNIORS</b>	<p>WAG COP modifications for Junior Competitions will apply.</p> <p><b>Qualification</b> The competition consists of Qualifications, which will also serve as the qualifications for the Apparatus Finals. Team and All-Around Final rankings will be determined by results of Qualifications. The competition consists of optional exercises on four apparatus.</p> <p>All the federations in good standing are entitled to participate either with a team of 3- 5 gymnasts (and 1 reserve) or with a maximum of 3 Individual gymnasts.</p>				

	<p>Each team consists of 3-5 gymnasts and can have up to 4 gymnasts per apparatus, with the top 3 scores counting toward the total team score.</p> <p>Gymnasts competing as individuals (not in a team) will also be eligible for All-Around ranking and Apparatus Finals qualification. The total scores of the gymnasts who perform on all the apparatus in competition, will determine the All-Around rankings (with maximum 2 gymnasts per federation). Only the first vault will count for the Team and All-Around ranking.</p> <p>To qualify for the vault final and in vault final, two different vaults (may be from the same group, but with different numbers) must be performed. The final score is based on the average of the two scores. NO Bonus will be awarded for performing vaults with saltos in different directions.</p> <p><b>Apparatus Finals</b> The top 8 gymnasts per apparatus (max 2 per country) from the Qualification round compete in the Apparatus Finals. Scores from the Qualification round are not carried over—gymnasts start fresh in this final. The results of the finals determine the champion on each apparatus.</p> <p><b>Tie-Breaking Rules</b> According to FIG TR 2025 (Article 7, Section 2), ties will generally remain UNBROKEN, with shared rankings unless specified for qualification purposes.</p> <p><b>Award Ceremonies</b> Award ceremonies will be held after each competition. The gymnasts are required to attend the Awards ceremonies. The medals will be granted to the top 3 gymnasts from each competition according to the result rankings. In team Finals/ranking, each gymnast receives the awards, including the reserve gymnast. The same award will be presented to one designated coach at the same time</p>
<p><b>COMPETITION FORMAT SENIORS</b></p>	<p>The competitions will be conducted according to FIG’s Technical Regulations 2025 including Section 2 for Artistic Gymnastics, Reg. 5.1, with the following modifications.</p> <p><b>Qualification</b> The competition consists of Qualifications, which will also serve as the qualifications for the Apparatus Finals. Team and All-Around Final rankings will be determined by results of Qualifications. The competition consists of optional exercises on four apparatus.</p> <p>All the federations in good standing are entitled to participate either with a team of 3- 5 gymnasts (and 1 reserve) or with a maximum of 3 Individual gymnasts. Each team consists of 3-5 gymnasts and can have up to 4 gymnasts per apparatus, with the top 3 scores counting toward the total team score.</p> <p>Gymnasts competing as individuals (not in a team) will also be eligible for All-Around ranking and Apparatus Finals qualification. The total scores of the gymnasts who perform on all the apparatus in competition, will determine the All-Around rankings (with maximum 2 gymnasts per federation). Only the first vault will count for the Team and All-Around ranking.</p> <p>To qualify for the vault finals, two vaults are necessary. The qualifying score is based on the average of the two scores.</p> <p><b>Apparatus Finals</b> The top 8 gymnasts per apparatus (max 2 per country) from the Qualification round compete in the Apparatus Finals. Scores from the Qualification round are not carried over—gymnasts start fresh in this final. The results of the finals determine the champion on each apparatus.</p> <p><b>Tie-Breaking Rules</b> In case of ties, the tie-breaking rules as defined in the FIG TR Art. 7 will be applied.</p>

**Award Ceremonies**

Award ceremonies will be held after each competition. The gymnasts are required to attend the Awards ceremonies.

The medals will be granted to the top 3 gymnasts from each competition according to the result rankings.

In team Finals/ranking, each gymnast receives the awards, including the reserve gymnast. The same award will be presented to one designated coach at the same time.

<b>MEDICAL SERVICES</b>	The Organizing Committee will provide a first medical aid service, a doctor and emergency medical transportation in the competition area and warm-up, Training halls.	

<b>DOPING CONTROLS</b>	Doping controls will be organized by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of the FIG and according to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), the international standards enacted by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.
<b>VISA</b>	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agency or the Embassy or Consulate of Republic of Korea in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Republic of Korea. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the Visa request is made to the LOC before <b>12 April 2025</b> and includes a clear copy of the valid passport (i.e. picture page with specific information), the identity of the applicants, the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, as well as the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member. <b>INSURANCE</b>	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the AGU will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. <b>SAFEGUARDING</b>	<p>From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable. The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site. In addition, posters of the "10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics", the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will have to be displayed in several locations, including training and warm-up halls and public zones.</p>
<b>INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 12 April 2025.</p>
<b>LOCAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	<p>Accredited Delegations who will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• stay at one of the official hotels,</li> <li>• book their accommodation through the LOC and</li> <li>• Submit the travel schedule information for arrivals and departures by 12 April 2025 at the latest,</li> </ul> <p>Will be provided with the local transportation free of charge from/to the airport and the official hotel as well as from/to the official hotel and the Competition, Training, and Warm-up Hall as well as any other official functions as needed. The costs for the accommodations must be paid in full to the LOC by **12 May 2025** as follows:

- At the time of the Definitive entry (i.e., 2 months prior to the event) 50% of the costs must be paid to the LOC.
- At the time of the Nominative entry (i.e. 1 month prior to the event) the remaining 50% i.e. 100% of the Accommodation costs must be paid to the LOC. Entries without the payment of the Accommodation costs will be considered as invalid and will be refused.

**Cancellation will only be accepted by e-mail.**

The LOC strongly recommend that each Federation take a cancellation insurance for their accommodations and meals (including paying Farewell Banquet tickets).

The cancellation policy is as follows:

- Up until 12 April 2025: 100 % refund
- 13 April – 12 May 2025: 50% refund
- From 13 May 2025: no refund.
- Only bank transfer will make refund.
- All costs for the bank transfers will be at the charge of the participating federations.
