



## LOS ANGELES 2028 OLYMPIC GAMES SELECTION PROCEDURES FOR TRAMPOLINE JUDGES



### Order of selection

- Chair of Judges Panel and Difficulty judges
- Execution judges
- Reserve Judges

### Rules for all nominated judges

- Maximum one judge per NF
- No current National Federation (NF) President or Secretary General from the time of nomination until the conclusion of the 2028 Los Angeles Olympic Games
- No ongoing disciplinary proceedings – Judges who are subject to disciplinary proceedings under FIG or GEF at the time of nomination, or at any point until the conclusion of the 2028 Olympic Games, are ineligible.
- No prior sanctions or warnings – Judges who have received a warning letter or any other sanction from the Gymnastics Ethics Foundation (GEF) during the current cycle are ineligible.

### Chair of Judges Panel (CJP) and Difficulty (D) judges

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Judges with a statistically significant same-nationality bias over all the eligible competitions, as calculated by JEP, are not eligible.</li></ul> |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Tie-break: The judge who has the most data (deductions entered) for E-judging</li></ul>   |



## **Execution (E) judges**

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Brevet awarded for a minimum of 2 cycles</li></ul>   |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Experience 1: must participate in at least 3 competitions during the qualifying process 2025-2027, including one World Championships.</li></ul>      |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Criteria: Highest accuracy score in the judges' evaluation program (JEP) for E-judging element per element (only individual competitions).</li></ul> |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Judges with a statistically significant same-nationality bias over all the eligible competitions, as calculated by JEP, are not eligible.</li></ul>  |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Tie-break: The judge who has the most data (deductions entered) for E-judging</li></ul>  |

## **Quota Numbers for TRA**

| <i>*CJP and D positions, according to the FIG General Judges' Rules, can only be taken by Cat. 1 judges.</i> |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A minimum of 3 judges per gender must be observed.</li></ul>         |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A reserve list will also be produced.</li></ul>                      |

## **Competitions' Phases evaluated**

During each competition, Q1, Q2 and Finals in Individual Trampoline will be evaluated.

Every competition will be divided in five competition phases, so judges can be evaluated in:

- Men's Q1
- Women's Q1
- Men's Q2
- Women's Q2
- Finals
