SELECTION PROCEDURES FOR MEN'S AND WOMEN'S ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS JUDGES

Order of selection

- Difficulty (D) judges
- Execution (E) judges
- Reserve (RES) judges

Rules for all judges nominated

- MAG: Max two per NOC (one D and one E)
- WAG: Max one per NOC
- No current National Federation (NF) President or Secretary General from the time of nomination until the conclusion of the Los Angeles 2028 Olympic Games.
- No prior sanctions or warnings – Judges who have received a warning letter or any other sanction from the Gymnastics Ethics Foundation (GEF) during the current cycle are ineligible.
- No ongoing disciplinary proceedings – Judges who are subject to disciplinary proceedings, under FIG or GEF at the time of nomination or at any point until the conclusion of the 2028 Olympic Games are ineligible.

Difficulty (D) Judges

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Category 1 only
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Experience – Two competitions required as a D judge, Apparatus Supervisor or Superior Jury member.• At least one competition must be from the following: Senior World Championships (WCH), Junior World Championships (JWCH), or Youth Olympic Games (YOG).• The other competition experience can be attained at an Apparatus World Cup 2026 or 2027.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Highest Examination Difficulty Result at the 2024 Intercontinental Judges' Course.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tie-break – from the 2024 Intercontinental Judges' Course examination.• MAG Average of best 4 apparatus• WAG average of best 3 apparatus
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The MTC and WTC will make the assignments to each apparatus.

Execution Judges (E). & Reserve Judges (RES)

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Category 1 or 2 only, no priority based on category, brevet for a minimum of 2 cycles including current cycle.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Competitions taken into consideration for the selection of E & Reserve judges:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- 2025, 2026 & 2027 Senior World Championships (WCH)- 2025 & 2027 Junior World Championships (JWCH)- 2026 Youth Olympic Games (YOG)- 2026 & 2027 Apparatus World Cups



<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Experience (Minimum Eligibility): must have served as a E judge at a minimum at 2 separate competitions, one of them being a Senior World Championships (WCH), Junior World Championships (JWCH) or Youth Olympic Games (YOG).
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Experience (Minimum Requirement): must have judged at least 3 phases as an E judge and a minimum of 50 routines in total from the competitions taken into consideration for the selection of E judges at Olympic Games.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The selection is based on the rank order of the overall JEP E-jury accuracy score across all the competitions in the selection procedure that the judge has been active in. Judges with a “Poor” grade in this overall report will not be considered. However, a “Poor” grade in an individual phase will not preclude a judge from consideration.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Judges with a statistically significant same-nationality bias for any of the eligible competitions, as calculated by JEP, are not eligible. Judges with a statistically significant same-nationality bias over all the eligible competitions, as calculated by JEP, are not eligible.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> JEP PCVR scores (TC Review) from the Team, All-Around, Apparatus Finals, and Mixed Team Final will only be used for Senior World Championships (WCH), Junior World Championships (JWCH), and Youth Olympic Games (YOG), or in exceptional cases where significant discrepancies are found.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tie-break: by number of routines judged. The judge with the highest number of routines will prevail.

Reserve Judges (RES) – additional information

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The next two judges ranked below those to be nominated for E positions.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Guaranteed to actively judge a minimum of one phase as an E judge.

E-Jury Selection Contingency

In case there are not enough eligible judges (selection of E) based on competitions and phases, the overall JEP accuracy score will be used with the following parameters in order:

- 2 Competitions and 2 phases, if still not enough eligible judges, then
- 1 Competition and 2 phases

Additional Superior Jury Member- MAG

- Must meet the minimum requirements for D judge nomination.
- Must have served as a Superior Jury Member during the cycle at the Senior World Championships (WCH), Junior World Championships (JWCH), or Youth Olympic Games (YOG)
- Final nomination by the MTC President
