One club team composed of one junior gymnast and two senior gymnasts per federation can participate.</p> <p>The cost of the international flights and accommodation for the official members of the top five teams/federations in the Aeon Cup 2024 will be covered by the LOC.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Accommodation to be arranged and covered by the LOC: 7 nights from 8 October to 14 October 1 triple room for 3 gymnasts 1 twin-bedded room for a coach and a judge</li><li>- Official members: 3 gymnasts, 1 coach, and 1 judge</li></ul> <p>Top five federations of the Aeon Cup 2024: USA, UKR, ITA, HUN and JPN <b>Depending on the situation in the future, some federations may not be allowed to participate in the Aeon Cup 2025.</b> The LOC reserves the right to limit the number of participating federations in case the number of entries exceeds more than expected.</p>

<b>VISA</b>	<p>If a VISA is required for entry into Japan, depending on the nationality of the participant, the LOC will send the necessary information and an application form.</p> <p>If the participating members have already been fixed, even at the time of provisional entry, necessary information for the VISA will be issued.</p> <p>Please bring the application form to the relevant embassy for the VISA issuance.</p>	
<b>INSURANCE</b>	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC, and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation, and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness (including COVID-19), accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. The LOC will verify the insurance coverage upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). The insurance must be valid at least starting from the arrival day of the delegation and must last for the delegations' entire stay.</p> <p>If basic insurance is not provided in your country of residence, the delegation can purchase it after arrival in Japan by paying JPY1,000 per day/person for the insurance arranged by the LOC.</p>	

<b>SAFEGUARDING</b>	<p>From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable.</p> <p>The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site.</p> <p>In addition, posters of the “10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics”, the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will have to be displayed in several locations, including training and warm-up halls and public zones.</p>
<b>INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	<p>The official airports for this event are Haneda International Airport and Narita International Airport.</p> <p>Participating federations must cover the travel costs of their delegation members except for the federations of the top five teams of the last Aeon Cup which took place in 2024.</p> <p>Top five federations of the Aeon Cup 2024: The international flight of the five (3 gymnasts, coach, and judge) official delegation members will be covered by the LOC (economy class).</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by July. 10, 2025.</p>
<b>LOCAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	<p>The LOC will provide free local transportation for all participants from/to the official airports to the official hotel in Tokyo as well as from/to the official hotel and the competition venue.</p>

CANCELATION POLICY	<p>Each team’s accommodation will be arranged as per the form submitted by each team.</p> <p>If a team is unable to come to the event due to the team’s circumstances and must cancel their accommodation, a cancellation fee will be charged, and the team is responsible for the cancellation fee.</p> <p>(* The Organizing Committee will pay for the accommodation expenses for 3 gymnasts, 1 coach and 1 judge of the top 5 teams in the AEON CUP 2024 for the official period of 7 nights from October 8 to October 14. However, if a team in the top 5 teams cancels due to their own reasons, they are also be responsible for any cancellation fees).</p> <p>If any of your team’s members who are registered in the accommodation form is unable to come to the event, please contact the Organizing Committee as soon as possible.</p> <p>10% cancellation fee will be applied from 60 days prior to the first day of reservation.</p> <p>20% cancellation fee will be applied from 30 days prior to the first day of reservation.</p> <p>80% cancellation fee will be applied from 10 days to 2 days prior to the first day of reservation.</p> <p>100% cancellation fee will be applied for cancellations on the day before, on the day of the stay, or no-show.</p>
