DRAWING OF LOTS PROCEDURES

We are pleased to provide you with the drawing of lots procedures for the individuals (RGI) and groups (RGG) gymnasts competing at the 41st FIG Rhythmic Gymnastics World Championships in Rio de Janeiro (BRA).

General principles:

The order of the apparatus for RGI and RGG are pre-defined (Hoop and Ball, Clubs and Ribbon for RGI, 5 Ribbons, 3 Balls and 2 Hoops for RGG).

- The drawing of lots will be carried out by computer for all phases of competitions
- The drawing of lots will be conducted in the following order of priority:
 1. RGI qualification
 2. RGI all-around final
 3. RGI apparatus finals
 4. RGG all-around competition (qualification)
 5. RGG finals

Individual competitions – qualifications

General principles:

- 1) One (1) drawing of lots will be conducted with all participating National Federations (NFs)
- 2) The drawing of lots will then be divided into four (4) equal groups, A, B, C and D (equal if possible, depending on the final total number of NFs)
- 3) Each group will then be cut into two subgroups (A1/A2, B1/B2, C1/C2, D1/D2)

Day 1:

- Group A (A1/A2) will start the competition followed by groups B (B1/B2), C (C1/C2), and D (D1/D2)
- When all NFs from group A have their gymnast performed on their first apparatus (Hoop and Ball alternately), they will rotate to perform on the second apparatus (Ball and Hoop alternately)
- Same principle for sub-groups B, C and D.



Day 2:

- Sub-group B (B2/B1) will start the competition followed by groups A (A2/A1), D (D2/D1), and C (C2/C1)
- When all NFs from sub-group B have their gymnast performed on their first apparatus (Clubs and Ribbon alternately) they will rotate to perform on the second apparatus (Ribbon and Clubs alternately)
- Same principle for sub-groups A, D and C.

Individual all-around final

Two (2) draws will be carried out as follows:

First draw, group B:

- One (1) drawing of lots will be conducted with the individual gymnasts ranked 10 – 18 from the qualifications.

Second draw, group A:

- One (1) drawing of lots will be conducted with the individual gymnasts ranked 1 – 9 from the qualifications.

Individual apparatus finals

The starting order for each apparatus final will be determined by four (4) different drawing of lots.

Group all-around competition (qualifications)

General principles:

- 1) One (1) drawing of lots will be conducted with all participating NFs
- 2) The drawing of lots will be then divided into two (2) equal groups, A and B (equal if possible, depending on the final total number of NFs)

- Group A will start the competition and perform alternatively the exercise using one type of apparatus and two types of apparatus. Then a rotation is made within group A for all groups to perform the second exercise (two types of apparatus and one type of apparatus)
- Same principle for group B.

Group routine finals

The starting order for each routine final will be determined by two (2) different drawing of lots
