<b>FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS</b>	<p>Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the FIG or the LOC may not be allowed to participate in this FIG World Challenge Cup. Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Local Organizing Committee by the given deadlines mentioned in these Directives may still have the possibility to participate, but the LOC will not guarantee the hotel booking, meals and local transportation. Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Organizing Member federations upon arrival will not be accredited.</p>																																				
<b>PARTICIPATION AND FIG LICENCE</b>	<p>Only senior gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid FIG License may participate. The Organizing Committee will be responsible for checking the validity of the gymnasts' licenses. No gymnasts will be accepted without a valid FIG License at the deadline of the Nominative Registration. <b>ENTRY FEES</b>	<b>The non-reimbursable cost for the Entry Fee (approved by the FIG) is of 50 EUR per gymnast</b>		
<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	<p>At the time of arrival, every delegation will be brought to the Accreditation centre in the Hotel where they will receive the accreditations which will allow access into the training and competition halls and all relevant information.</p> <p>The accreditation is personal and non-transferable and must be used at all times.</p> <p>In case of loss, the Head of Competition must be contacted immediately.</p> <p>The participants which will not book their arrangements through the OC, the price for accreditation is 250 EUR per person. This accreditation allows him/her to enter the warm-up and competition hall and to attends the banquet.</p> <p>In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the safeguarding Officer operations plan upon accreditation.</p>		
<b>COMPETITION FORMAT</b>	<p>The World Challenge Cup competitions consist of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Qualifications and Apparatus Finals</li> <li>• Gymnasts can only compete on the apparatus they register for</li> <li>• In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up in the Technical Regulations, Section 2 shall be applied.</li> </ul> <p><u>Qualifications:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Participation is limited to 2 gymnasts per NF on each apparatus.</li> <li>▪ In addition, the Organizing Member Federation is allowed to name a max. of 4 "hors concours" competitors (from the Organizing Member Federation) in Women's Artistic Gymnastics and a max. of 4 "hors concours" competitors (from the Organizing Member Federation) in Men's Artistic Gymnastics for a total of 8 "hors concours" gymnasts (i.e. while one "hors concours" gymnast can compete on more than one apparatus, not more than one "hors concours" gymnast can compete on an apparatus). They must be named at the time of the closing of the nominative registration and they cannot qualify for the Finals. They are not eligible to receive World Challenge Cup points, they must not appear on the official results lists and they will have to start first at every apparatus.</li> <li>▪ A competitor can be registered as "Gymnast" on an apparatus and as "Hors-Concours Gymnast" on another apparatus.</li> <li>▪ FIG Apparatus Finals rules will be applied for vault.</li> </ul> <p><u>Finals:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The best eight gymnasts per apparatus from the qualifications qualify for the Finals</li> <li>▪ Participation is limited to 2 gymnasts per NF on each apparatus.</li> <li>▪ In addition to the 8 finalists, if the Organizing Member Federation is not represented in the Finals (men or women), it has the right of maximum 2 wild cards as follows (1 man and 1 woman gymnast only at one</li> </ul>

Gymnasts entering in Apparatus Final with wild card will have to start first.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• These “Wild Card Gymnasts” must have participated at the respective apparatus in the qualifications.</li> <li>• “Wild Card Gymnasts” will receive medals and prize money.</li> <li>• Wild Card Gymnasts” will receive World Challenge Cup points (if any) based on the ranking obtained during Qualifications.</li> <li>• FIG Apparatus Finals rules will be applied for vault.</li> </ul>																					
<b>DRAWING OF LOTS</b>	<p>The gymnasts' drawing of lots for all FIG World Challenge Cup events will be managed electronically.</p> <p>If not possible, it will take place on site, during the orientation meeting or during a separate function organized for that purpose with invitation to all participating NFs. All delegations upon arrival/accreditation must submit a confirmation of starting order forms, a final validation of the delegation's apparatus and starting order.</p> <p>The Technical Delegates may apply adjustments to the starting order should the Draw generate organizational problems at the time of the competition.</p> <p>At the time of the nominative registration, the apparatus on which the gymnast will compete must be mentioned. <b>Until accreditation</b>, Gymnasts may be changed, and apparatus can be added, as long as 2 gymnasts per apparatus per federation is respected</p>

<b>ANTI-DOPING</b>	<p><b><u>Doping controls</u></b></p> <p>Doping controls will be organised by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of the FIG and according to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), the international standards enacted by the World Anti-doping Agency (WADA) and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.</p> <p><b><u>Host federation WADC compliance</u></b></p> <p>The exploitation of any rights related to the hosting of an event is subject, at all times, to the compliance with the WADC and the international standards enacted by WADA.</p> <p>Regardless of whether the event has already been allocated or not, the FIG may terminate any collaboration with the host federation or the LOC, immediately and without paying any penalty and/or compensation or incurring liability of any kind, under the following circumstances:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) if the National Anti-Doping Organisation (NADO) in charge in the concerned country is declared non-compliant by WADA</li> <li>(ii) if the relevant country has been ruled ineligible to host the event.</li> </ul> <p>In such cases, the FIG is entitled to reassign the event to any other host federation in another country where the WADC and the WADA international standards are fully respected.</p>
<b>VISA</b>	Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Slovenian Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Slovenia. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made at the latest by 30 <sup>th</sup> April 2026 to the LOC. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to. They must also indicate whether an electronic invitation letter is sufficient for them to obtain a visa or they would like to receive it in physical form by post. In this case, they will also bear the postage costs.
<b>INSURANCE</b>	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Please also refer to <a href="https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php">https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php</a> for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges.</p> <p>If the note has not been sent in advance to the LOC (which is strongly recommended), the LOC will verify the insurance coverage upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy).</p> <p>The insurance must be valid at least starting from the arrival day of the delegation and must last for the delegations' entire stay</p> <p>Delegation members with insufficient insurance coverage must inform the LOC in advance. <b>INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p><b>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 30 April 2026</b></p>

Entries without the payment of the 50% of the accommodation and meals costs will be considered as invalid and will be refused. The remaining 50% of the Accommodation costs must be paid by 30 April 2026.</p> <p>In case of room cancellations until 28 March 2026 the OC will refund the complete amount of annulled rooms and meals. In case of room cancellations until 30 April 2026 the OC will refund 50 % of the amount of annulled rooms and meals. In case of room cancellations after 30 April 2026, no claims of refunds will be accepted.</p>
<b>MEALS</b>	<p>All accommodation packages include breakfast and dinner (half board).</p> <p>Lunch will also be available at a price of 34 € per person per one lunch.</p> <p>Price for additional dinner (not included in half board) is 34 € per person per one dinner.</p> <p>If the delegation arrives/departs outside the restaurant's opening hours, it is possible to order food packages that will be waiting for the delegation at the reception.</p> <p>The invited participating federations must pay for the meals' expenses of their delegation members (see exception herein below).</p> <p>While the Meals Form must be returned to the LOC by 30 April 2026 at the very latest, the costs for the meals must be paid to the LOC by 30 April 2026 as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ 28 March 2026 – 50% of the costs</li> <li>➤ 30 April 2026 – the rest of the 50% of the costs.</li> </ul> <p>The deadlines for order meals as well as their payment are the same as it is for the accommodation. <b>FINAL BANQUET</b>	<p>The banquet will take place on Saturday evening and is intended for all participants who have arranged their accommodation through LOC or have purchased accreditations.</p> <p>All others can purchase tickets for the Final Banquet. The tickets will be available at 50 EUR per person.</p>
<b>FIG TECHNICAL DELEGATE</b>	<p>The FIG Technical Delegates will be designated by the FIG.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Delegates will serve as Presidents of the Superior Jury.</p>
<b>WAG FX MUSIC</b>	<p>An online system, proposed by the FIG, will be used to download the floor music of all gymnasts, to provide information on the musical data and to help the NFs ensure that all music is correctly authorized for use in competition.</p> <p>Music Forms sent by email in .xls format will not be accepted.</p>

<b>JUDGES AND PANELS</b>	<p>Each Judge's panel will be composed as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2 D judges</li> <li>• Minimum 4 E judges</li> </ul> <p><i>Note: for minimum category requirement, please refer to the FIG General Judges' Rules</i></p> <p>Not more than one judge per Federation per panel will be permitted (except for Time and Line Judges).</p> <p>The number of judges' panels will be decided by the organizing member federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges.</p> <p>The judges' panels are set up by a draw from the judges present at the Judges meeting. The draw must be directed by the MAG and WAG Technical Delegates. The participating member federations must send minimum one qualified judge for MAG if they participate with male gymnasts and one qualified WAG judge if they participate with female gymnasts.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation will apply a fine of CHF 2'000 per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC) should a federation fail to bring the required number of judges. This fine must be paid to the LOC by 30 April 2026.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, the Organizing Member Federation must propose to the FIG for approval the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves, 1 for MAG and 1 for WAG). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation. Such invitation must be made through the respective Member Federation. No prize money, medals and World Challenge Cup points will be given, if there are less than 4 participating federation per apparatus.

In case of a tie at any rank, the prize money of the equal ranks is added and divided by the number of ties.

In case that less than four federations participating per apparatus, no World Challenge Cup points will be given.
