We're quickly approaching The World Games 2025 and hence we would like to remind you on a few important timelines and actions required.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1 - BULLETIN N°4

Attached we are sending the LOC Bulletin N°4, which was already sent to all NF. Please read it carefully and follow the instructions included.

2 - ACCOMMODATION

All FIG participants will be accommodated in the Village A:
Tianfu International Hotel Complex - Rong Jin Courtyard, Jianyang, Sichuan, Chine

3 - TRANSPORTATION

Attached we are sending the ACRO, AER and TRA Transportation Schedule 20250724. Please note that priority is given always to the participants in the trainings/competitions. PK Transport schedule will follow in the coming days.

4 - WADA Anti-Doping Education and Learning (ADEL)

A few hours ago, a reminder was sent to all athletes and medical personnel require ADEL certificate **but have not provided a valid certificate. Only ADEL certificates from 1 August 2023 onwards are valid, no certificates issued by NADOs or any other bodies other than WADA will be valid. The date format is DD/MM/YYYY** (Please note that English ADEL certificates have the date format MM/DD/YYYY).

At present, 45 participants have not yet completed the course (**see excel spreadsheet attached**).

A daily verification until 31 July will take place and follow up reminders will be sent until then. However, we strongly recommend everybody should have done the course by **31 July 2025** and uploaded the certificate as previously communicated.

Important: Any certificates which will not be confirmed or uploaded by then will need to be physically presented on site before accreditations can be handed out. If participants fail to do the course beforehand, it will be necessary to complete it in Chengdu upon arrival.

5 - INSURANCE

As mentioned in Bulletin N°4, “According to the IWGA Rules of The World Games, all IFs must ensure that their participants are adequately insured with personal health insurance and repatriation insurance. The coverage must include their travel to and from the host country, as well as their stay in Chengdu.”

All delegations, including, but not limited to, all IWGA participants, are required to have the following personal health and accident insurance coverage during the Games time:

Item	Minimum Coverage (CNY)
Accidental Death and Disability	1,000,000
Accidental Medical Expenses	1,000,000
Death from Infectious Disease	500,000
Death from Acute Illness	500,000
Medical Expenses for Acute Illness	1,000,000
Coverage for Hospitalisation Expenses	Insurance must cover hospitalisation expenses.

6 – JUDGES UNIFORM

According to information from the Local Organizing Committee (LOC), all judges will receive a TWG 2025 Uniform.

Please note that those who submitted their uniform size after May 9, 2025, might experience some difficulties in finding their size.

The FIG requires all judges to travel with their FIG Uniform as a backup, in case there are any issues with the LOC uniforms or if some judges are unable to wear them.

Synchronised Trampoline

Qualifying Round :

Only 8 pairs competing in a single group.

Draw have been conducted in Lausanne on the 5th of July.

Qualification are conducted according to Code of Point 1.2.2, 1.2.3, 1.2.5 and 1.2.8

Tie breaking rules see Technical Regulations section 4 art 3.4

Semi Finals :

Semi Finals (4 pairs): 1st pair ranked in Qualifying Round against the 4th pair, and 2nd pair ranked in Qualifying Round against 3rd /pair.

The starting order is determine by merit order, the best ranked pair from qualification will compete last.

In semi final, pairs can repete elements or exercises from qualfication.

Tie breaking rules see Technical Regulations section 4 art 3.4

Finals :

Bronze medal final: the 2 losers of Semi Finals competing for the bronze medal.

Gold medal final: the 2 winners of Semi Finals compete for the gold medal.

The finals will start with Bronze medal final, followed by Gold medal final.

The starting order is determine by merit order, the best ranked pair from semi finals will compete last.

In final, pairs can repete elements or exercises from qualfication or semi finals.

Tie breaking rules see Technical Regulations section 4 art 3.4

Tumbling

Qualifying Round :

Only 8 gymnasts competing in a single group.

Draw have been conducted in Lausanne on the 5th of July.

Qualification are conducted according to Code of Point 1.2.2, 1.2.3, 1.2.5 and 1.2.8

In semi final, gymnast can repeat elements or exercises from qualification.

Tie breaking rules see Technical Regulations section 4 art 3.4

Finals:

Bronze medal final: the 2 losers of Semi Finals competing for the bronze medal.

Gold medal final: the 2 winners of Semi Finals compete for the gold medal.

The finals will start with Bronze medal final, followed by Gold medal final.

The starting order is determined by merit order, the best ranked gymnast from semi finals will compete last.

In final, gymnast cannot repeat elements or exercises from semi finals.

Qualifying Round :

Only 8 gymnasts competing in a single group.

Semi Finals:

The specific requirements are as follows:

1. Each delegation must email the competition music for ACRO.
2. When submitting competition music, the delegation is required **to name the music file and fill the email subject in this way: event-gender-nation/region-athlete name** (ex: ACRO-Men Pair-USA-LAST NAME First Name_exercise BDC).
3. The music submitted by each delegation should be in an MP3 file for direct use without further edition. The audio sample rate should be above 16-bit 44KHz.

We recommend traveling with a copy of the music(s) in a pen drive for general training and in case of any technical issue.

1. Each delegation must email the competition music for AER.
2. When submitting competition music, the delegation is required **to name the music file and fill the email subject in this way: event-gender-nation/region-athlete name** (ex: AER-Mixed Group-USA).
3. The music submitted by each delegation should be in an MP3 file for direct use without further edition. The audio sample rate should be above 16-bit 44KHz.

We recommend traveling with a copy of the music(s) in a pen drive for general training and in case of any technical issue.
