<b>PARTICIPANTS</b>	The Organizing Member Federation will invite all Member Federations in good standing.

	Delegation will consist of 1-2 Senior and (or) 1-2 junior individual gymnasts. Please note that it is possible to participate with maximum 2 seniors and (or) maximum 2 juniors per country (except of NF).
<b>AGE</b>	Junior & Senior, <b>as per FIG Technical Regulations</b> . All gymnasts must have an FIG licence valid until the end of the event.
<b>JUDGES</b>	<b>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event.</b> If a Federation does not enter a judge or comes with a judge of an insufficient level, LOC will request the payment of a fine of <b>200 EUR</b> per missing judge.
<b>ENTRY FEES</b>	The entry fee for this event will be: <b>75 EUR</b> per each individual gymnast. The entry fee is non-refundable.
<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	Delegations must present (if not sent by email previously): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Passports/ID cards of gymnasts</li> <li>• Insurance for all members of delegations</li> <li>• FIG licenses for gymnasts and judges</li> <li>• Music for all exercises of gymnasts (USB)</li> <li>• Receipt of payment of start fee, accommodation (if applicable).</li> </ul> In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.
<b>EVENT FORMAT</b>	<b><u>Junior RGI (FIG Rules)</u></b> ALL-AROUND AND QUALIFICATION FOR FINALS Each gymnast performs 4 exercises Each Federation can participate with 2 gymnasts (NF may participate with more gymnasts – maximum 4). APPARATUS FINAL – Finals (the best 8 gymnasts per apparatus – max 1 per federation). In addition, if not qualified, the NF may participate in the four finals with more gymnasts, at its free choice. <b><u>Senior RGI (FIG Rules)</u></b> ALL-AROUND AND QUALIFICATION FOR FINALS Each gymnast performs 4 exercises Each Federation can participate with 2 gymnasts (NF may participate with more gymnasts – maximum 4). APPARATUS FINAL – Finals (the best 8 gymnasts per apparatus – max 2 per federation). In addition, if not qualified, the NF may participate in the four finals with more gymnasts, at its free choice.

<b>REGISTRATION AND MUSIC</b>	Nominative registration deadline is <b>03.01.2026</b> . The nominative registration of gymnasts, inscription of judges and coaches should be done exclusively via <a href="https://rgform.eu/event.php?id_prop=9199">https://rgform.eu/event.php?id_prop=9199</a> Music's (mp3) must be uploaded in KSIS not later than <b>11.01.2026</b>
<b>VISA</b>	Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Luxembourgish Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Luxembourg. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, if the request is made before <b>15.12.2025</b> to the LOC. To request an invitation letter, please send the following information to the LOC: Full Name, Gender, Date of Birth, Citizenship, Passport Number, Passport Expiry Date, Function/Role within the Delegation, Arrival and Departure Dates, City where the visa application support letter should be sent.

	Please ensure that all information is complete and accurate to avoid delays in visa processing.

<b>SAFEGUARDING</b>	<p>From the <b>official day of arrival</b> until the <b>official day of departure</b>, all participants — including <b>gymnasts, coaches, judges, and other Delegation Members</b> — will have the possibility to <b>contact the LOC Safeguarding Officer</b> by phone or email in case of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Harassment</li> <li>• Abuse of any kind</li> <li>• Any situation where they feel uncomfortable or unsafe</li> </ul> <p>The <b>contact information</b> for the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be <b>provided to all Delegations upon arrival</b> on site.</p> <p>As part of the FIG's commitment to athlete welfare and youth protection, <b>posters of the “10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics”</b>, part of the FIG's awareness campaign, must be <b>clearly displayed</b> in several key areas, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Training Halls</li> <li>• Warm-Up Areas</li> <li>• Public Zones</li> </ul> <p>These measures are in place to ensure a <b>safe, respectful, and supportive environment</b> for all participants throughout the event.</p>
<b>INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by <b>03.01.2026</b> .
